Present Tense	<b>criminate / criminates</b>
Past Tense	<b>criminated</b>
Present Participle	<b>criminating</b>
Past Participle	<b>criminated</b>

## Conjugate Criminate

**Criminate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

I <b>criminate</b>	We <b>criminate</b>
You <b>criminate</b>	You <b>criminate</b>
He/She/It <b>criminate</b> s	They <b>criminate</b>

**Criminate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>am criminating</b>	We <b>are criminating</b>
You <b>are criminating</b>	You <b>are criminating</b>
He/She/It <b>is criminating</b>	They <b>are criminating</b>

**Criminate in Present Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>have criminated</b>	We <b>have criminated</b>
You <b>have criminated</b>	You <b>have criminated</b>
He/She/It <b>has criminated</b>	They <b>have criminated</b>

**Criminate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>have been criminating</b>	We <b>have been criminating</b>
You <b>have been criminating</b>	You <b>have been criminating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been criminating</b>	They <b>have been criminating</b>

**Criminate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>criminated</b>	We <b>criminated</b>
You <b>criminated</b>	You <b>criminated</b>
He/She/It <b>criminated</b>	They <b>criminated</b>

**Criminate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

<b>I was criminating</b>	<b>We were criminating</b>
<b>You were criminating</b>	<b>You were criminating</b>
<b>He/She/It was criminating</b>	<b>They were criminating</b>

**Criminate in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had criminated</b>	<b>We had criminated</b>
<b>You had criminated</b>	<b>You had criminated</b>
<b>He/She/It had criminated</b>	<b>They had criminated</b>

**Criminate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had been criminating</b>	<b>We had been criminating</b>
<b>You had been criminating</b>	<b>You had been criminating</b>
<b>He/She/It had been criminating</b>	<b>They had been criminating</b>

**Criminate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will criminate</b>	<b>We will criminate</b>
<b>You will criminate</b>	<b>You will criminate</b>
<b>He/She/It will criminate</b>	<b>They will criminate</b>

**Criminate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will be criminating</b>	<b>We will be criminating</b>
<b>You will be criminating</b>	<b>You will be criminating</b>
<b>He/She/It will be criminating</b>	<b>They will be criminating</b>

**I will have criminated**

**We will have criminated**

**You will have criminated**

**You will have criminated**

**He/She/It will have criminated**

**They will have criminated**

**We will have been criminating**

**You will have been criminating**
