- *A regional term for `creature' (especially for domestic animals).*
- *A living creature; an animal.*
- *A person of a particular kind.*



Synonyms of "Critter" as a noun (9 Words)

- animal** An animal as opposed to a human being.
*The snowfall seemed to have chased all birds **animals** and men indoors.*
- beast** An animal as opposed to a human.
*A scheming manipulative little **beast**.*
- brute** A cruel or insensitive person.
*He was a cold blooded **brute**.*
- creature** A living organism characterized by voluntary movement.
*Night sounds of birds and other **creatures**.*
- fellow** A man or boy.
*The page has been torn away from its **fellows**.*
- individual** A single organism.
*Boat trips for parties and **individuals**.*

- man** A manservant or valet.
*Jeeves was Bertie Wooster's **man**.*
- person** A category used in the classification of pronouns possessive determiners and verb forms according to whether they indicate the speaker first person the addressee second person or a third party third person.
*The entrance fee is 2 00 per **person**.*
- woman** A disrespectful form of address to a woman.
*Don't be daft **woman**.*
