**crumbly** Consisting of or easily breaking into small fragments.

The cheese has a sharp flavour and is **crumbly** and moist.

Denoting ammunition designed to disintegrate into very small particles on

**frangible** impact.

The museum stored all **frangible** articles in locked showcases.

friable Easily crumbled.

Friable carcinomatous tissue.
