Definitions of "Crunchy" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “crunchy” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Politically liberal and environmentally aware.*
- *Making a sharp noise when bitten or crushed.*



Synonyms of "Crunchy" as an adjective (6 Words)

- breakable** Capable of breaking or being broken easily.
*An encrypted password isn't easily **breakable**.*
- brittle** Not annealed and consequently easily cracked or fractured.
*Her manner was artificially bright and **brittle**.*
- crispy** (of food) having a firm, dry, and brittle surface or texture.
***Crispy** fried bacon.*
- crumbly** Consisting of or easily breaking into small fragments.
*The cheese has a sharp flavour and is **crumbly** and moist.*
- frangible** Denoting ammunition designed to disintegrate into very small particles on impact.
*The museum stored all **frangible** articles in locked showcases.*
- friable** Easily crumbled.
***Friable** carcinomatous tissue.*



Usage Examples of "Crunchy" as an adjective

- *A song that incorporates whale-singing seems pretty crunchy.*
- *Bake until the topping is crunchy.*
