Infinitive	<b>to cry</b>
Present Tense	<b>cry / cries</b>
Past Tense	<b>cried</b>
Present Participle	<b>crying</b>
Past Participle	<b>cried</b>

## Conjugate Cry

**Cry in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>cry</b>	We <b>cry</b>
You <b>cry</b>	You <b>cry</b>
He/She/It <b>cries</b>	They <b>cry</b>

### **Cry in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am crying</b>	We <b>are crying</b>
You <b>are crying</b>	You <b>are crying</b>
He/She/It <b>is crying</b>	They <b>are crying</b>

### **Cry in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have cried</b>	We <b>have cried</b>
You <b>have cried</b>	You <b>have cried</b>
He/She/It <b>has cried</b>	They <b>have cried</b>

### **Cry in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been crying</b>	We <b>have been crying</b>
You <b>have been crying</b>	You <b>have been crying</b>
He/She/It <b>has been crying</b>	They <b>have been crying</b>

### **Cry in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>cried</b>	We <b>cried</b>
You <b>cried</b>	You <b>cried</b>
He/She/It <b>cried</b>	They <b>cried</b>

### **Cry in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

I <b>was crying</b>	We <b>were crying</b>
You <b>were crying</b>	You <b>were crying</b>
He/She/It <b>was crying</b>	They <b>were crying</b>

**Cry in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>had cried</b>	We <b>had cried</b>
You <b>had cried</b>	You <b>had cried</b>
He/She/It <b>had cried</b>	They <b>had cried</b>

**Cry in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>had been crying</b>	We <b>had been crying</b>
You <b>had been crying</b>	You <b>had been crying</b>
He/She/It <b>had been crying</b>	They <b>had been crying</b>

**Cry in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>will cry</b>	We <b>will cry</b>
You <b>will cry</b>	You <b>will cry</b>
He/She/It <b>will cry</b>	They <b>will cry</b>

**Cry in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>will be crying</b>	We <b>will be crying</b>
You <b>will be crying</b>	You <b>will be crying</b>
He/She/It <b>will be crying</b>	They <b>will be crying</b>

**I will have cried**

**We will have cried**

**You will have cried**

**You will have cried**

**He/She/It will have cried**

**They will have cried**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been crying**

**We will have been crying**

**You will have been crying**

**You will have been crying**

**He/She/It will have been crying**

**They will have been crying**
