- *A piece of a homogeneous solid substance having a natural geometrically regular form with symmetrically arranged plane faces.*
- *A clear transparent mineral, especially quartz.*
- *A rock formed by the solidification of a substance; has regularly repeating internal structure; external plane faces.*
- *Glassware made of quartz.*
- *Articles made of crystal glass.*

- *Highly transparent glass with a high refractive index.*
- *Colorless glass made of almost pure silica.*

<b>crystallization</b>	A rock formed by the solidification of a substance; has regularly repeating internal structure; external plane faces. <i>A beautiful object is a <b>crystallization</b> of a beautiful idea.</i>
<b>crystalware</b>	Ornaments and articles made from crystal glass. <i>The finalists all received bouquets and <b>crystalware</b>.</i>
<b>glassware</b>	An article of tableware made of glass.
<b>lechatelierite</b>	Colorless glass made of almost pure silica.
<b>quartz</b>	A hard glossy mineral consisting of silicon dioxide in crystal form present in most rocks especially sandstone and granite yellow sand is quartz with iron oxide impurities.
<b>quartz glass</b>	Colorless glass made of almost pure silica.

**watch crystal** A small portable timepiece.

**watch glass** The period during which someone (especially a guard) is on duty.

<b>cryogenic</b>	Relating to or involving the branch of physics that deals with the production and effects of very low temperatures. <i>A powerful <b>cryogenic</b> engine.</i>
<b>crystallize</b>	Assume crystalline form become crystallized. <i>The sale may not <b>crystallize</b> the charge.</i>
<b>freeze</b>	Cause to freeze. <i>A nuclear <b>freeze</b>.</i>
<b>frost</b>	The formation of frost or ice on a surface. <i>It is not unusual for buds to be nipped by <b>frost</b>.</i>
<b>glacier</b>	A slowly moving mass of ice.
<b>granite</b>	Something having the quality of granite unyielding firmness. <i><b>Granite</b> columns.</i>
<b>icicle</b>	Ice resembling a pendent spear, formed by the freezing of dripping water.
<b>jadeite</b>	A green, blue, or white mineral which is one of the forms of jade. It is a silicate of sodium, aluminium, and iron and belongs to the pyroxene group.
<b>jewelry</b>	An adornment (as a bracelet or ring or necklace) made of precious metals and set with gems (or imitation gems).
<b>limestone</b>	A sedimentary rock consisting mainly of calcium that was deposited by the remains of marine animals.
<b>marble</b>	A sculpture carved from marble. <i>A couple of girls were playing <b>marbles</b>.</i>
<b>mineral</b>	Relating to minerals. <i>A wide range of necessary vitamins and <b>minerals</b>.</i>
<b>nephrite</b>	A hard, pale green or white mineral which is one of the forms of jade. It is a silicate of calcium and magnesium.
<b>phial</b>	A small cylindrical glass bottle, typically used for medical samples or for potions or medicines. <i>A <b>phial</b> of blood.</i>
<b>porphyry</b>	Any igneous rock with crystals embedded in a finer groundmass of minerals.
<b>quartz</b>	A hard glossy mineral consisting of silicon dioxide in crystal form present in most rocks especially sandstone and granite yellow sand is quartz with iron oxide impurities.
<b>refrigerant</b>	Causing cooling or freezing. <i>A <b>refrigerant</b> substance such as ice or solid carbon dioxide.</i>
<b>refrigerate</b>	Subject (food or drink) to cold in order to chill or preserve it, typically by placing it in a refrigerator. <i><b>Refrigerate</b> this medicine.</i>

- rhinestone** An imitation diamond, used in cheap jewellery and to decorate clothes.  
***Rhinestone** earrings.*
- rock** A large piece of rock which has become detached from a cliff or mountain a boulder.  
*The police discovered six ounces of **rock** in his van.*
- silicon** The chemical element of atomic number 14 a non metal with semiconducting properties used in making electronic circuits Pure silicon exists in a shiny dark grey crystalline form and as an amorphous powder.
- snow** Falls of snow.  
*The first **snows** of winter.*
- snowflake** A crystal of snow.  
*These little **snowflakes** will soon discover that life doesn't come with trigger warnings.*
- solidify** Make solid or more solid cause to solidify.  
*Social and political pressures helped to **solidify** national identities.*
