Associations of "Culinary" (30 Words)

bake	A social gathering at which baked food of a specified kind is eaten. <i>Lobster bakes.</i>
baked	Intoxicated by drink or drugs, especially cannabis. <i>Baked apples.</i>
baker	Someone who bakes bread or cake. <i>A waffle baker.</i>
baste	A loose temporary sewing stitch to hold layers of fabric together. <i>Baste a roast.</i>
bread	The bread or wafer used in the Eucharist. <i>I hate doing this but I need the bread.</i>
cake	An item of soft sweet food made from a mixture of flour, fat, eggs, sugar, and other ingredients, baked and sometimes iced or decorated. <i>A starter of goat s cheese and potato cakes.</i>
chef	Work as a chef. <i>He chuffed on a yacht in the Riviera for two years.</i>
cook	A person who prepares and cooks food especially as a job or in a specified way. <i>Susan was a school cook.</i>
cookbook	A book of recipes and cooking directions.
cooked	(of food or a meal) prepared by heating. <i>Cooked chicken can last longer than two days when stored properly.</i>
cookery	The act of preparing something (as food) by the application of heat. <i>People are needed who have experience in cookery.</i>
cooking	Suitable for or used in cooking. <i>He developed an interest in cooking.</i>
cornbread	Bread made primarily of cornmeal.

crispy	Tender and brittle. <i>Crispy fried bacon.</i>
crust	Form a crust or form into a crust. <i>The bread crusted in the oven.</i>
cuisine	Food cooked in a certain way. <i>Much Venetian cuisine is based on seafood.</i>
flour	Sprinkle something especially a work surface or cooking utensil with a thin layer of flour. <i>Flour fish or meat before frying it.</i>
gastronomy	A particular style of cookery (as of a region). <i>Traditional American gastronomy.</i>
goody	Something attractive or desirable, especially something tasty to eat.
grill	Cook over a grill. <i>A grill pan.</i>
homemade	Made or produced in the home or by yourself. <i>Homemade bread.</i>
microwave	A short electromagnetic wave longer than infrared but shorter than radio waves used for radar and microwave ovens and for transmitting telephone facsimile video and data. <i>You can microwave the leftovers.</i>
miller	Someone who works in a mill (especially a grain mill).
oven	Used to describe a very hot place. <i>Bake the dish in a preheated oven.</i>
paste	Coat with paste. <i>Paste the wall with burlap.</i>
pastry	An item of food consisting of sweet pastry with a cream jam or fruit filling. <i>Spread the mixture over the pastry.</i>
preparation	The cognitive process of thinking about what you will do in the event of something happening. <i>He left the preparation of meals to his wife.</i>
<u>recipe</u>	Directions for making something. <i>Sky high interest rates are a recipe for disaster.</i>
<u>sandwich</u>	Something that is constructed like or has the form of a sandwich. <i>The degree includes a sandwich year.</i>
tamp	A tool for tamping e.g. for tamping tobacco into a pipe bowl or a charge into a drill hole etc. <i>Tamp the coffee grinds in the container to make espresso.</i>
