He/She/It is cursing	They are cursing

Curse in Present Perfect Tense

I have cursed or curst (archaic)	We have cursed or curst (archaic)
You have cursed or curst (archaic)	You have cursed or curst (archaic)
He/She/It has cursed or curst (archaic)	They have cursed or curst (archaic)

Curse in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been cursing	We have been cursing
You have been cursing	You have been cursing
He/She/It has been cursing	They have been cursing

Curse in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Curse in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had cursed or curst (archaic)	We had cursed or curst (archaic)
You had cursed or curst (archaic)	You had cursed or curst (archaic)
He/She/It had cursed or curst (archaic)) They had cursed or curst (archaic)

Curse in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been cursing	We had been cursing
You had been cursing	You had been cursing
He/She/It had been cursing	They had been cursing

Curse in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will curse	We will curse
You will curse	You will curse
He/She/It will curse	They will curse

Curse in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be cursing	We will be cursing
You will be cursing	You will be cursing
He/She/It will be cursing	They will be cursing
