### Definitions of "Cushion" as a noun

- *A mechanical damper; absorbs energy of sudden impulses.*
- *A bag of cloth stuffed with a mass of soft material, used as a comfortable support for sitting or leaning on.*
- *A soft bag filled with air or a mass of padding such as feathers or foam rubber etc.*
- *The layer of air supporting a hovercraft or similar vehicle.*
- *The elastic lining of the sides of a billiard table, from which the ball rebounds.*
- *Something providing support or protection against impact.*
- *The layer of air that supports a hovercraft or similar vehicle.*

- bolster** A part on a vehicle or tool providing structural support or reducing friction.
- buffer** A temporary memory area in which data is stored while it is being processed or transferred, especially one used while streaming video or downloading audio.

- bulwark** A protective structure of stone or concrete; extends from shore into the water to prevent a beach from washing away.

*Despite heavy pressure the **defence** was coping well.*
- headrest** A rest for the head.



- pillow** A rectangular cloth bag stuffed with feathers or other soft materials, used to support the head when lying or sleeping.
- protection** Protection money paid to criminals especially on a regular basis.  
*Most European climbers drill bolts into rock rather than using removable **protection**.*
- shield** A sporting trophy shaped like a shield consisting of an engraved metal plate mounted on a piece of wood.  
*Team captain Ben Hall collected the winners **shield**.*
- shock** A pile of sheaves of grain set on end in a field to dry; stalks of Indian corn set up in a field.  
*He was numb with **shock**.*
- shock absorber** Bodily collapse or near collapse caused by inadequate oxygen delivery to the cells; characterized by reduced cardiac output and rapid heartbeat and circulatory insufficiency and pallor.

- *Underlay forms a cushion between carpet and floor.*

<b>dull</b>	Make or become dull or less intense. <i>Time <b>dulls</b> the memory.</i>
<b>lessen</b>	Make smaller. <i>The warmth of the afternoon <b>lessened</b>.</i>
<b>mitigate</b>	Lessen or to try to lessen the seriousness or extent of. <i>Drainage schemes have helped to <b>mitigate</b> this problem.</i>
<b>muffle</b>	Make (a sound) quieter or less distinct. <i><b>Muffle</b> one's anger.</i>
<b>protect</b>	Shield from danger, injury, destruction, or damage. <i>Security products are designed to <b>protect</b> information from unauthorized access.</i>
<b>reduce the effect of</b>	Reduce in scope while retaining essential elements.
<b><u>shelter</u></b>	Provide shelter for. <i>We are <b>sheltered</b> from the awfulness of reality.</i>
<b><u>shield</u></b>	Remain apart from others for a period of time in order to avoid catching an infectious disease to which one may be particularly vulnerable. <i>He pulled the cap lower to <b>shield</b> his eyes from the glare.</i>
<b>soften</b>	Remove mineral salts from (water). <i>The blockade appears a better weapon with which to <b>soften</b> them up for eventual surrender.</i>
<b><u>stifle</u></b>	Impair the respiration of or obstruct the air passage of. <i>She <b>stifled</b> a giggle.</i>
<b>take the edge off</b>	Require as useful, just, or proper.
<b><u>temper</u></b>	Make more temperate acceptable or suitable by adding something else. <i><b>Temper</b> glass.</i>

<b>cornice</b>	Furnish with a cornice.
<b>couch</b>	Lower (a spear) to the position for attack. <i>The child was lying on the examination <b>couch</b>.</i>
<b>curtain</b>	A raising or lowering of the curtain at the beginning or end of an act or scene. <i><b>Curtain</b> the bedrooms.</i>
<b>desk</b>	A counter in a hotel, bank, or airport at which a customer may check in or obtain information. <i>A <b>desk</b> job.</i>
<b>drape</b>	Place casually. <i><b>Drape</b> the statue with a sheet.</i>
<b>drapery</b>	The depiction of folds of cloth in sculpture or painting. <i>The hall of the school was hung with green <b>drapery</b>.</i>
<b>droop</b>	Droop sink or settle from or as if from pressure or loss of tautness. <i>James hid his face in his hands and <b>drooped</b> his head.</i>
<b>fabric</b>	The body of a car or aircraft. <i>Heavy cream <b>fabric</b>.</i>
<b>furniture</b>	Furnishings that make a room or other area ready for occupancy. <i>There was only one piece of <b>furniture</b> in the room.</i>
<b>mat</b>	A piece of coarse material for lying on. <i>Sweat <b>matted</b> his hair.</i>
<b>mattress</b>	A flat structure of concrete, brushwood, or other material, used as strengthening or support for foundations, embankments, etc.

<b>quilt</b>	A knitted or fabric bedspread with decorative stitching. <i><b>Quilt</b> the skirt.</i>
<b>recliner</b>	A chair with a reclining back, especially one with an integral footrest.
<b>rug</b>	A thick woollen coverlet or wrap, used especially when travelling. <i>Men who shave their heads or wear <b>rugs</b>.</i>
