# **Conjugate Cyanate**

#### **Cyanate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>cyanate</b>	We <b>cyanate</b>
You <b>cyanate</b>	You <b>cyanate</b>
He/She/It <b>cyanates</b>	They cyanate

## **Cyanate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am cyanating	We <b>are cyanating</b>
You <b>are cyanating</b>	You <b>are cyanating</b>
He/She/It is cyanating	They <b>are cyanating</b>

## **Cyanate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have cyanated	We have cyanated
You have cyanated	You have cyanated
He/She/It has cyanated	They have cyanated

## **Cyanate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been cyanating	We have been cyanating
You have been cyanating	You have been cyanating
He/She/It has been cyanating	They have been cyanating

## **Cyanate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I cyanated	We <b>cyanated</b>
You <b>cyanated</b>	You <b>cyanated</b>
He/She/It <b>cyanated</b>	They <b>cyanated</b>

## **Cyanate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

#### **Cyanate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had cyanated	We had cyanated
You <b>had cyanated</b>	You had cyanated
He/She/It had cyanated	They had cyanated

#### **Cyanate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been cyanating	We had been cyanating
You <b>had been cyanating</b>	You had been cyanating
He/She/It had been cyanating	They had been cyanating

#### **Cyanate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will cyanate	We <b>will cyanate</b>
You <b>will cyanate</b>	You <b>will cyanate</b>
He/She/It will cyanate	They will cyanate

### **Cyanate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be cyanating	We will be cyanating
You <b>will be cyanating</b>	You <b>will be cyanating</b>
He/She/It will be cyanating	They will be cyanating
