Singular Plural

I daisy-chain We daisy-chain
You daisy-chain You daisy-chain
He/She/It daisy-chains They daisy-chain

Daisy-chain in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am daisy-chaining We are daisy-chaining
You are daisy-chaining
He/She/It is daisy-chaining They are daisy-chaining

Daisy-chain in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have daisy-chained We have daisy-chained You have daisy-chained He/She/It has daisy-chained They have daisy-chained

Daisy-chain in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been daisy-chaining
You have been daisy-chaining
He/She/It has been daisy-chaining
They have been daisy-chaining

Daisy-chain in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I daisy-chained We daisy-chained
You daisy-chained You daisy-chained
He/She/It daisy-chained They daisy-chained

Daisy-chain in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was daisy-chaining We were daisy-chaining
You were daisy-chaining
He/She/It was daisy-chaining They were daisy-chaining

Daisy-chain in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had daisy-chained We had daisy-chained
You had daisy-chained You had daisy-chained
He/She/It had daisy-chained They had daisy-chained

Daisy-chain in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been daisy-chaining
You had been daisy-chaining
He/She/It had been daisy-chaining
They had been daisy-chaining

Daisy-chain in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will daisy-chain We will daisy-chain
You will daisy-chain You will daisy-chain
He/She/It will daisy-chain They will daisy-chain

Daisy-chain in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be daisy-chaining
You will be daisy-chaining
He/She/It will be daisy-chaining
They will be daisy-chaining

Daisy-chain in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have daisy-chained We will have daisy-chained You will have daisy-chained He/She/It will have daisy-chained They will have daisy-chained

Daisy-chain in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been daisy-chaining
You will have been daisy-chaining
He/She/It will have been daisy-chaining
They will have been daisy-chaining
