Present Tense	<b>dander / danders</b>
Past Tense	<b>dandered</b>
Present Participle	<b>dandering</b>
Past Participle	<b>dandered</b>

## Conjugate Dander

### Dander in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **dander**

We **dander**

You **dander**

You **dander**

He/She/It **danders**

They **dander**

## **Dander in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am dandering**

We **are dandering**

You **are dandering**

You **are dandering**

He/She/It **is dandering**

They **are dandering**

## **Dander in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have dandered**

We **have dandered**

You **have dandered**

You **have dandered**

He/She/It **has dandered**

They **have dandered**

## **Dander in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been dandering**

We **have been dandering**

You **have been dandering**

You **have been dandering**

He/She/It **has been dandering**

They **have been dandering**

## **Dander in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **dandered**

We **dandered**

You **dandered**

You **dandered**

He/She/It **dandered**

They **dandered**

## **Dander in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was dandering</b>	<b>We were dandering</b>
<b>You were dandering</b>	<b>You were dandering</b>
<b>He/She/It was dandering</b>	<b>They were dandering</b>

**Dander in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had dandered</b>	<b>We had dandered</b>
<b>You had dandered</b>	<b>You had dandered</b>
<b>He/She/It had dandered</b>	<b>They had dandered</b>

**Dander in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been dandering</b>	<b>We had been dandering</b>
<b>You had been dandering</b>	<b>You had been dandering</b>
<b>He/She/It had been dandering</b>	<b>They had been dandering</b>

**Dander in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will dander</b>	<b>We will dander</b>
<b>You will dander</b>	<b>You will dander</b>
<b>He/She/It will dander</b>	<b>They will dander</b>

**Dander in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will be dandering</b>	<b>We will be dandering</b>
<b>You will be dandering</b>	<b>You will be dandering</b>
<b>He/She/It will be dandering</b>	<b>They will be dandering</b>

**Dander in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have dandered**

**We will have dandered**

**You will have dandered**

**You will have dandered**

**He/She/It will have dandered** **They will have dandered**

**Dander in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been dandering**

**We will have been dandering**

**You will have been dandering**

**You will have been dandering**

**He/She/It will have been dandering** **They will have been dandering**
