# **Conjugate Dang**

#### Dang in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>dang</b>	We <b>dang</b>
You <b>dang</b>	You <b>dang</b>
He/She/It dangs	They dang

#### Dang in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am danging	We <b>are danging</b>
You <b>are danging</b>	You <b>are danging</b>
He/She/It is danging	They <b>are danging</b>

#### **Dang in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have danged	We have danged
You <b>have danged</b>	You have danged
He/She/It has danged	They have danged

#### **Dang in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been danging	We have been danging
You <b>have been danging</b>	You have been danging
He/She/It has been danging	They have been danging

#### Dang in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I danged	We <b>danged</b>
You <b>danged</b>	You <b>danged</b>
He/She/It danged	They <b>danged</b>

#### **Dang in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was danging	We <b>were danging</b>
You <b>were danging</b>	You were danging
He/She/It was danging	They were danging

#### **Dang in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had danged	We had danged
You <b>had danged</b>	You <b>had danged</b>
He/She/It had danged	They had danged

#### **Dang in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been danging	We had been danging
You <b>had been danging</b>	You <b>had been danging</b>
He/She/It had been danging	They had been danging

### Dang in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will dang</b>	We <b>will dang</b>
You <b>will dang</b>	You <b>will dang</b>
He/She/It will dang	They will dang

### Dang in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be danging	We will be danging
You <b>will be danging</b>	You <b>will be danging</b>
He/She/It will be danging	They will be danging

#### **Dang in Future Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been danging	We <b>will have been danging</b>
You <b>will have been danging</b>	You <b>will have been danging</b>
He/She/It will have been danging	They will have been danging
