## Synonyms of "Dapper" as an adjective (22 Words)

<b>besuited</b>	(of a person, especially a man) wearing a suit. <i><b>Besuited</b> politicians have been taking part in televised debates.</i>
<b>chic</b>	Elegantly and stylishly fashionable. <i><b>Chic</b> elegance.</i>
<b>crisp</b>	(of a substance) firm, dry, and brittle. <i>Her answer was <b>crisp</b>.</i>
<b>dashing</b>	Lively and spirited. <i>A <b>dashing</b> hero.</i>
<b>debonair</b>	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air. <i>A <b>debonair</b> gentleman.</i>
<b>elegant</b>	(of a scientific theory or solution to a problem) pleasingly ingenious and simple. <i>An <b>elegant</b> comfortable house.</i>
<b>jaunty</b>	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air. <i>A <b>jaunty</b> red hat.</i>
<b>natty</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. <i>A <b>natty</b> blue blazer.</i>
<b>neat</b>	(of liquid, especially spirits) not diluted or mixed with anything else. <i>Alan noted down the orders in his <b>neat</b> precise script.</i>
<b>neat and tidy</b>	Very good.
<b>raffish</b>	Marked by a carefree unconventionality or disreputableness. <i>A cocktail party given by some <b>raffish</b> bachelors.</i>
<b>rakish</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. <i>He had a <b>rakish</b> debonair look.</i>
<b>smart</b>	Having or showing a quick-witted intelligence. <i><b>Smart</b> children talk earlier than the average.</i>
<b>smartly dressed</b>	Capable of independent and apparently intelligent action.
<b>snappy</b>	Cleverly concise; neat. <i><b>Snappy</b> catchphrases.</i>
<b>spiffy</b>	Smart in appearance. <i>A <b>spiffy</b> new outfit.</i>
<b>spruce</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners.
<b>tidy</b>	Of hair neat and tidy. <i>His scrupulously <b>tidy</b> apartment.</i>

- trim** Severely simple in line or design.  
A *trim* beard.
- well dressed** Resulting favorably.
- well groomed** Wise or advantageous and hence advisable.
- well turned out** Wise or advantageous and hence advisable.

<b>abreast</b>	Being up to particular standard or level especially in being up to date in knowledge. <i>They were riding three <b>abreast</b>.</i>
<b><u>alongside</u></b>	Side by side.
<b><u>chic</u></b>	Elegantly and stylishly fashionable. <i>She looked every inch the <b>chic</b> Frenchwoman.</i>
<b>craze</b>	A fine crack in a glaze or other surface. <i><b>Crazed</b> by hunger the population began to turn on the rebels.</i>
<b>fad</b>	An interest followed with exaggerated zeal. <i>His <b>fads</b> about the type of coffee he must have.</i>
<b>faddish</b>	Intensely fashionable or popular for a short period of time. <i>Tastes in flavoured coffee are so <b>faddish</b>.</i>

<b>fashion</b>	The latest and most admired style in clothes and cosmetics and behavior. <i>She <b>fashioned</b> a tent out of a sheet and a few sticks.</i>
<b><u>fashionable</u></b>	Popular and considered appealing or fashionable at the time. <i>They risked being scoffed at by their more <b>fashionable</b> friends.</i>
<b>inimitable</b>	So good or unusual as to be impossible to copy; unique. <i>An <b>inimitable</b> style.</i>
<b>jaunty</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. <i>There was no mistaking that <b>jaunty</b> walk.</i>
<b>lately</b>	In the recent past. <i>She hasn't been looking too well <b>lately</b>.</i>
<b><u>latest</u></b>	The most recent news or fashion. <i>Have you heard the <b>latest</b>.</i>
<b><u>modern</u></b>	Belonging to the modern era since the Middle Ages. <i><b>Modern</b> history.</i>
<b>modish</b>	In the current fashion or style. <i>It seems sad that such a scholar should feel compelled to use this <b>modish</b> jargon.</i>
<b>natty</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. <i>A palmtop computer with many <b>natty</b> features.</i>
<b>newfangled</b>	Different from what one is used to; objectionably new. <i><b>Newfangled</b> ideas.</i>
<b>raffish</b>	Unconventional and slightly disreputable, especially in an attractive way. <i>A cocktail party given by some <b>raffish</b> bachelors.</i>
<b>rakish</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. <i>He had a <b>rakish</b> debonair look.</i>
<b>recency</b>	The property of having happened or appeared not long ago.
<b>recent</b>	New. <i>His <b>recent</b> visit to Britain.</i>
<b>recently</b>	In the recent past. <i>I <b>recently</b> bought a CD player.</i>
<b><u>seductive</u></b>	Tending to entice into a desired action or state. <i>A <b>seductive</b> voice.</i>
<b>smart</b>	Mental pain or suffering. <i>You look very <b>smart</b>.</i>
<b>spruce</b>	Light soft moderately strong wood of spruce trees used especially for timbers and millwork. <i>He <b>spruced</b> up for the party.</i>
