backwards	(of a movement) in the direction of one's back. Penny glanced backwards .
<u>battered</u>	Having suffered repeated violence from a spouse, partner, or parent. <i>His battered old hat.</i>
bygone	Past events to be put aside. The museum consists of a fascinating collection of rural bygone s.
<u>elder</u>	An official in the early Christian Church, or of various Protestant Churches and sects. <i>The elder of the two sons.</i>
ex	The 24th letter of the Roman alphabet. All his ex es live in T ex as.



expired	Having come to an end or become void after passage of a period of time. <i>An expired passport.</i>
hoary	Used in names of animals and plants covered with whitish fur or short hairs e g hoary bat hoary cress. A hoary old fellow with a face of white stubble.
inoperative	Not working or taking effect. An inoperative law.
<u>invalid</u>	Having no cogency or legal force. <i>Her invalid husband</i> .
<u>null</u>	Combine a signal with another in order to create a null cancel out. The establishment of a new interim government was declared null and void.
<u>obsolete</u>	Cause a product or idea to become obsolete by replacing it with something new. <i>The disposal of old and obsolete machinery.</i>
old	Used informally especially for emphasis old adj of a very early stage in development. We moved back into our old house.
outdated	Out of date; obsolete. <i>Outdated</i> equipment.
outmoded	Out of fashion. An outmoded Victorian building.
paleolithic	Of or relating to the second period of the Stone Age (following the eolithic. <i>Paleolithic</i> artifacts.
passe	Out of fashion.
past	A verb tense that expresses actions or states in the past. Forget the past .
retrograde	Show retrograde motion. All the planets will at some time appear to retrograde .
<u>rusty</u>	(of black clothes) discoloured by age. <i>Rusty</i> deposits.
<u>senile</u>	(of a person) having or showing the weaknesses or diseases of old age, especially a loss of mental faculties. Senile decay.
superannuated	Too old to be useful. A superannuated hippy.



<u>useless</u>	Having no ability or skill in a specified activity or area. We tried to pacify him but it was useless .
widower	A man whose spouse is often away participating in a specified sport or activity. Her new found passion has turned me into a tennis widower .
