Daylight in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I daylight We daylight
You daylight You daylight
He/She/It daylights They daylight

Daylight in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am daylighting We are daylighting
You are daylighting You are daylighting
He/She/It is daylighting They are daylighting

Daylight in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have daylighted or daylit
You have daylighted or daylit
He/She/It has daylighted or daylit
They have daylighted or daylit

Daylight in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been daylighting
You have been daylighting
He/She/It has been daylighting
They have been daylighting

Daylight in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I daylighted or daylit
You daylighted or daylit
He/She/It daylighted or daylit
They daylighted or daylit

Daylight in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was daylighting We were daylighting
You were daylighting You were daylighting
He/She/It was daylighting They were daylighting

Daylight in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had daylighted or daylit
You had daylighted or daylit
He/She/It had daylighted or daylit
They had daylighted or daylit

Daylight in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been daylighting We had been daylighting
You had been daylighting You had been daylighting
He/She/It had been daylighting They had been daylighting

Daylight in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will daylight We will daylight
You will daylight You will daylight
He/She/It will daylight They will daylight

Daylight in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be daylighting We will be daylighting
You will be daylighting You will be daylighting
He/She/It will be daylighting They will be daylighting

Daylight in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have daylighted or daylit
You will have daylighted or daylit
He/She/It will have daylighted or daylit
They will have daylighted or daylit

Daylight in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been daylighting
You will have been daylighting
He/She/It will have been daylighting
They will have been daylighting
