Daysail in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I daysail	We daysail
You daysail	You daysail
He/She/It daysails	They daysail

Daysail in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am daysailing	We are daysailing
You are daysailing	You are daysailing
He/She/It is daysailing	They are daysailing

Daysail in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have daysailed	We have daysailed
You have daysailed	You have daysailed
He/She/It has daysailed	They have daysailed

Daysail in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been daysailing	We have been daysailing
You have been daysailing	You have been daysailing
He/She/It has been daysailing	They have been daysailing

Daysail in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I daysailed	We daysailed
You daysailed	You daysailed
He/She/It daysailed	They daysailed

Daysail in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had daysailed	We had daysailed
You had daysailed	You had daysailed
He/She/It had daysailed	They had daysailed

Daysail in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been daysailing	We had been daysailing
You had been daysailing	You had been daysailing
He/She/It had been daysailing	They had been daysailing

Daysail in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will daysail	We will daysail
You will daysail	You will daysail
He/She/It will daysail	They will daysail

Daysail in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be daysailing	We will be daysailing
You will be daysailing	You will be daysailing
He/She/It will be daysailing	They will be daysailing

Daysail in Future Perfect Tense

I will have daysailed	We will have daysailed
You will have daysailed	You will have daysailed
He/She/It will have daysailed	They will have daysailed

I will have been daysailing	We will have been daysailing
You will have been daysailing	You will have been daysailing
He/She/It will have been daysailing	They will have been daysailing
