Associations of "Dealt" (30 Words)

agent	Any agent or representative of a federal agency or bureau. <i>A trained intelligence agent.</i>
apportionment	The action or result of apportioning something. <i>The apportionment of blame.</i>
auction	Sell or offer for sale at an auction. <i>The painting was auctioned at Christie s.</i>
auctioneer	A person who conducts auctions by accepting bids and declaring goods sold.
<u>bargain</u>	Negotiate the terms and conditions of a transaction. <i>He didn t bargain on this storm.</i>
buy	Be a buyer for a store or firm. <i>The stock was a real buy at that price.</i>
buyer	A person who buys.
contract	Contract bridge the highest bid becomes the contract setting the number of tricks that the bidder must make. <i>He contracted a debt of 3 300.</i>
<u>cope</u>	A long cloak; worn by a priest or bishop on ceremonial occasions. <i>His ability to cope with stress.</i>
fishmonger	Someone who sells fish.
grapple	To grip or seize, as in a wrestling match. <i>He grappled the young man around the throat.</i>
handle	Handle effectively. <i>He handled himself with considerable aplomb.</i>
huckster	Wrangle (over a price, terms of an agreement, etc). <i>He was huckstering a video.</i>
manage	Be the manager of a sports team or a performer. <i>She manages horses better than anyone I know.</i>

marketer	A person or company that advertises or promotes something. <i>A leading manufacturer and marketer of medical products.</i>
<u>marketplace</u>	The world of commercial activity where goods and services are bought and sold. <i>The changing demands of the global marketplace.</i>
outsell	Sell more than others. <i>This salesman outsells his colleagues.</i>
peddle	Promote (an idea or view) persistently or widely. <i>He was arrested after trying to peddle guns.</i>
price	Attach price labels or tickets to an item for sale. <i>The watches are priced at 55.</i>
purchaser	A person who buys something; a buyer. <i>One of the club's prospective purchasers.</i>
<u>salesman</u>	A man salesperson. <i>An insurance salesman.</i>
salesperson	A salesman or saleswoman (used as a neutral alternative).
sell	An act of selling or attempting to sell something. <i>I was trying to sell him my butterfly collection.</i>
<u>seller</u>	A product that sells in some specified way. <i>The book became the biggest seller in the history of royal publishing.</i>
storekeeper	A merchant who owns or manages a shop.
trading	The action or activity of buying and selling goods and services. <i>Trading profits leapt.</i>
transact	Conduct business. <i>Transact with foreign governments.</i>
transferee	Someone who transfers or is transferred from one position to another.
vend	Sell (something). <i>There was a man vending sticky cakes and ices.</i>
<u>vendor</u>	Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money. <i>An Italian ice cream vendor.</i>
