# **Conjugate Dean**

## Dean in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>dean</b>	We <b>dean</b>
You <b>dean</b>	You <b>dean</b>
He/She/It <b>deans</b>	They <b>dean</b>

## **Dean in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am deaning</b>	We <b>are deaning</b>
You <b>are deaning</b>	You <b>are deaning</b>
He/She/It is deaning	They <b>are deaning</b>

#### **Dean in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have deaned	We have deaned
You have deaned	You have deaned
He/She/It has deaned	They have deaned

### **Dean in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been deaning	We have been deaning
You <b>have been deaning</b>	You have been deaning
He/She/It has been deaning	They have been deaning

## **Dean in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I deaned	We <b>deaned</b>
You <b>deaned</b>	You <b>deaned</b>
He/She/It <b>deaned</b>	They <b>deaned</b>

#### **Dean in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was deaning	We <b>were deaning</b>
You <b>were deaning</b>	You were deaning
He/She/It was deaning	They were deaning

#### **Dean in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had deaned	We had deaned
You <b>had deaned</b>	You had deaned
He/She/It had deaned	They had deaned

## **Dean in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been deaning	We had been deaning
You <b>had been deaning</b>	You had been deaning
He/She/It had been deaning	They had been deaning

## **Dean in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will dean</b>	We <b>will dean</b>
You <b>will dean</b>	You <b>will dean</b>
He/She/It will dean	They will dean

## **Dean in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be deaning	We <b>will be deaning</b>
You <b>will be deaning</b>	You <b>will be deaning</b>
He/She/It will be deaning	They will be deaning

#### **Dean in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

I will have been deaning	We <b>will have been deaning</b>
You <b>will have been deaning</b>	You <b>will have been deaning</b>
He/She/It will have been deaning	They will have been deaning
