Infinitive	<b>to debilitate</b>
Present Tense	<b>debilitate / debilitates</b>
Past Tense	<b>debilitated</b>
Present Participle	<b>debilitating</b>
Past Participle	<b>debilitated</b>

## Conjugate Debilitate

**Debilitate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **debilitate**                      We **debilitate**  
You **debilitate**                    You **debilitate**  
He/She/It **debilitates**      They **debilitate**

**Debilitate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am debilitating**                We **are debilitating**  
You **are debilitating**            You **are debilitating**  
He/She/It **is debilitating**      They **are debilitating**

**Debilitate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have debilitated**                We **have debilitated**  
You **have debilitated**            You **have debilitated**  
He/She/It **has debilitated**      They **have debilitated**

**Debilitate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been debilitating**        We **have been debilitating**  
You **have been debilitating**      You **have been debilitating**  
He/She/It **has been debilitating**      They **have been debilitating**

I **debilitated**                      We **debilitated**  
You **debilitated**                    You **debilitated**  
He/She/It **debilitated**          They **debilitated**

<b>I was debilitating</b>	<b>We were debilitating</b>
<b>You were debilitating</b>	<b>You were debilitating</b>
<b>He/She/It was debilitating</b>	<b>They were debilitating</b>

**Debilitate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had debilitated</b>	<b>We had debilitated</b>
<b>You had debilitated</b>	<b>You had debilitated</b>
<b>He/She/It had debilitated</b>	<b>They had debilitated</b>

**Debilitate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>I had been debilitating</b>	<b>We had been debilitating</b>
<b>You had been debilitating</b>	<b>You had been debilitating</b>
<b>He/She/It had been debilitating</b>	<b>They had been debilitating</b>

<b>I will be debilitating</b>	<b>We will be debilitating</b>

<b>He/She/It will be debilitating</b>	<b>They will be debilitating</b>
