- *A period of 10 years.*
- *Each of the five divisions of each chapter of the rosary.*
- *A range of electrical resistances, frequencies, or other quantities spanning from one to ten times a base value.*

*Children of primary school **age**.*
- century** A score of a hundred in a sporting event, especially a batsman's score of a hundred runs in cricket.

- decennary** A period of 10 years.
- decennium** A period of 10 years.
- epoch** A particular period of time in history or a person's life.  
*These events marked an **epoch** in their history.*
- era** A major division of geological time an era is usually divided into two or more periods.  
*The landing of this English governor was an **era** in their lives.*

- twelve** The cardinal number that is the sum of eleven and one.
- twenty** Denoting a quantity consisting of 20 items or units.
