- *A period of 10 years.*
- *Each of the five divisions of each chapter of the rosary.*
- *A range of electrical resistances, frequencies, or other quantities spanning from one to ten times a base value.*



Synonyms of "Decade" as a noun (14 Words)

- 10** The cardinal number that is the sum of nine and one; the base of the decimal system.
- age** A particular stage in someone's life.
*Children of primary school **age**.*
- century** A score of a hundred in a sporting event, especially a batsman's score of a hundred runs in cricket.
*The **fifteenth century**.*
- decennary** A period of 10 years.
- decennium** A period of 10 years.
- epoch** A particular period of time in history or a person's life.
*These events marked an **epoch** in their history.*
- era** A major division of geological time an era is usually divided into two or more periods.
*The landing of this English governor was an **era** in their lives.*

period	The interval between successive equal values of a periodic function. <i>Period pains.</i>
<u>stage</u>	The theater as a profession usually the stage. <i>There are only two characters on stage.</i>
ten	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
tenner	A ten-pound note.
time	A reading of a point in time as given by a clock. <i>The nurse came in four times a day.</i>
x	Street names for methylenedioxyamphetamine.
<u>year</u>	A set of students grouped together as being of roughly similar ages mostly entering a school or college in the same academic year. <i>She had a composure well beyond her years.</i>

- *The fourth decade of the nineteenth century.*
- *He taught at the university for nearly a decade.*

ago	Gone by; or in the past. <i>Two years ago.</i>
billion	The number that is represented as a one followed by 12 zeros; in the United Kingdom the usage followed in the United States is frequently seen.
century	Ten 10s. <i>A twentieth century lifestyle.</i>
eight	One of four playing cards in a deck with eight pips on the face.
eighty	The cardinal number that is the product of ten and eight.
eleven	Being one more than ten.
fifty	A United States bill worth 50 dollars.
five	A playing card or a domino or a die whose upward face shows five pips.
forties	The decade from 1940 to 1949.
forty	The cardinal number that is the product of ten and four.
fourteen	Being one more than thirteen.
hundred	Being ten more than ninety. <i>Wantage Hundred.</i>
millennium	A span of 1000 years. <i>Archer's treatise predicted that the millennium was close at hand.</i>
million	(in Roman numerals, M written with a macron over it) denoting a quantity consisting of 1,000,000 items or units. <i>There were millions of flies.</i>
nine	One of four playing cards in a deck with nine pips on the face.
nineteen	The cardinal number that is the sum of eighteen and one.
ninety	Being ten more than eighty.
ninth	Position nine in a countable series of things. <i>Going into the ninth they were a run ahead.</i>
percent	A proportion in relation to a whole (which is usually the amount per hundred).
seven	One of four playing cards in a deck with seven pips on the face.
seventeen	The cardinal number that is the sum of sixteen and one.
seventy	The cardinal number that is the product of ten and seven.
sixty	Being ten more than fifty.
span	The wingspan of an aircraft or a bird. <i>The parking lot spans 3 acres.</i>

- ten** One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
- tenfold** Ten times as great or as numerous.
*A **tenfold** increase in the use of insecticides.*
- thirty** The cardinal number that is the product of ten and three.
- thousand** Denoting a quantity consisting of 1,000 items or units.
- twelve** The cardinal number that is the sum of eleven and one.
- twenty** Denoting a quantity consisting of 20 items or units.
