Associations of "Deciphering" (30 Words)

cipher	A quantity of no importance. <i>He came across ciphers written on parchment and concealed in a hollow altar pillar.</i>
code	Convert ordinary language into code. <i>Most developers code C like C.</i>
coding	Functioning as the genetic code or determiner for an amino acid, protein, or characteristic. <i>PAYE codings.</i>
cryptic	Having a puzzling terseness. <i>He found his boss's utterances too cryptic.</i>
cryptogram	A text written in code.
cryptography	Act of writing in code or cipher.
decode	Analyse and interpret (a communication or image). <i>Studying reports poring over decodes.</i>
egyptian	Of or relating to or characteristic of Egypt or its people or their language.
encode	Convert information into code. <i>Encode pictures digitally.</i>
encrypt	Convert ordinary language into code. <i>Encrypted data.</i>
encryption	The process of converting information or data into a code, especially to prevent unauthorized access. <i>I use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online.</i>
enigmatic	Not clear to the understanding. <i>So enigmatic that priests might have to clarify it.</i>
factorize	Resolve (a polynomial) into factors. <i>All matrices can be factorized.</i>

glyph	A hieroglyphic character or symbol. <i>Flanges painted with esoteric glyphs.</i>
hash	Make meat or other food into a hash. <i>A hash of raw tomatoes chillies and coriander.</i>
hieroglyph	Writing that resembles hieroglyphics usually by being illegible. <i>The International Organisation for Standardization is introducing two new hieroglyphs to perplex washing machine owners.</i>
hieroglyphic	Resembling hieroglyphic writing. <i>A hieroglyphic sign.</i>
ideogram	A graphic character that indicates the meaning of a thing without indicating the sounds used to say it. <i>Chinese characters are ideograms.</i>
<u>inexplicable</u>	Incapable of being explained or accounted for. <i>Inexplicable errors.</i>
inscription	The action of inscribing something. <i>The inscription of memorable utterances on durable materials.</i>
<u>interpret</u>	Give an interpretation or explanation to. <i>Interpreting the music well takes hours of listening and experimentation.</i>
meaning	The message that is intended or expressed or signified. <i>What is the meaning of this proverb.</i>
mnemonic	Relating to the power of memory. <i>The usual mnemonic for star types is O Be A Fine Girl Kiss Me.</i>
oracular	Of or relating to an oracle. <i>He holds forth in oracular fashion.</i>
palimpsest	Something reused or altered but still bearing visible traces of its earlier form. <i>Sutton Place is a palimpsest of the taste of successive owners.</i>
password	A string of characters that allows access to a computer system or service. <i>If you don't know the password you can't come in.</i>
syllabic	Articulated in syllables. <i>Inuit syllabics.</i>
<u>text</u>	A text message. <i>There were more than a thousand words of text.</i>
transliterate	Rewrite in a different script. <i>Names from one language are often transliterated into another.</i>
word	The divine word of God the second person in the Trinity incarnate in Jesus. <i>He words his request in a particularly ironic way.</i>
