## Associations of "Deciphering" (30 Words)

<b>cipher</b>	A quantity of no importance. <i>He came across <b>ciphers</b> written on parchment and concealed in a hollow altar pillar.</i>
<a href="#">code</a>	Convert ordinary language into code. <i>Most developers <b>code</b> C like C.</i>
<b>coding</b>	Functioning as the genetic code or determiner for an amino acid, protein, or characteristic. <i>PAYE <b>codings</b>.</i>
<a href="#">cryptic</a>	Having a puzzling terseness. <i>He found his boss's utterances too <b>cryptic</b>.</i>
<b>cryptogram</b>	A text written in code.
<b>cryptography</b>	Act of writing in code or cipher.
<a href="#">decode</a>	Analyse and interpret (a communication or image). <i>Studying reports poring over <b>decodes</b>.</i>
<b>egyptian</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of Egypt or its people or their language.
<a href="#">encode</a>	Convert information into code. <i><b>Encode</b> pictures digitally.</i>
<b>encrypt</b>	Convert ordinary language into code. <i><b>Encrypted</b> data.</i>
<b>encryption</b>	The process of converting information or data into a code, especially to prevent unauthorized access. <i>I use <b>encryption</b> to protect sensitive information transmitted online.</i>
<b>enigmatic</b>	Not clear to the understanding. <i>So <b>enigmatic</b> that priests might have to clarify it.</i>
<b>factorize</b>	Resolve (a polynomial) into factors. <i>All matrices can be <b>factorized</b>.</i>

<b>glyph</b>	A hieroglyphic character or symbol. <i>Flanges painted with esoteric <b>glyphs</b>.</i>
<b>hash</b>	Make meat or other food into a hash. <i>A <b>hash</b> of raw tomatoes chillies and coriander.</i>
<b>hieroglyph</b>	Writing that resembles hieroglyphics usually by being illegible. <i>The International Organisation for Standardization is introducing two new <b>hieroglyphs</b> to perplex washing machine owners.</i>
<b>hieroglyphic</b>	Resembling hieroglyphic writing. <i>A <b>hieroglyphic</b> sign.</i>
<b>ideogram</b>	A graphic character that indicates the meaning of a thing without indicating the sounds used to say it. <i>Chinese characters are <b>ideograms</b>.</i>
<b><u>inexplicable</u></b>	Incapable of being explained or accounted for. <i><b>Inexplicable</b> errors.</i>
<b>inscription</b>	The action of inscribing something. <i>The <b>inscription</b> of memorable utterances on durable materials.</i>
<b><u>interpret</u></b>	Give an interpretation or explanation to. <i><b>Interpreting</b> the music well takes hours of listening and experimentation.</i>
<b>meaning</b>	The message that is intended or expressed or signified. <i>What is the <b>meaning</b> of this proverb.</i>
<b>mnemonic</b>	Relating to the power of memory. <i>The usual <b>mnemonic</b> for star types is O Be A Fine Girl Kiss Me.</i>
<b>oracular</b>	Of or relating to an oracle. <i>He holds forth in <b>oracular</b> fashion.</i>
<b>palimpsest</b>	Something reused or altered but still bearing visible traces of its earlier form. <i>Sutton Place is a <b>palimpsest</b> of the taste of successive owners.</i>
<b>password</b>	A string of characters that allows access to a computer system or service. <i>If you don't know the <b>password</b> you can't come in.</i>
<b>syllabic</b>	Articulated in syllables. <i>Inuit <b>syllabics</b>.</i>
<b><u>text</u></b>	A text message. <i>There were more than a thousand words of <b>text</b>.</i>
<b>transliterate</b>	Rewrite in a different script. <i>Names from one language are often <b>transliterated</b> into another.</i>
<b>word</b>	The divine word of God the second person in the Trinity incarnate in Jesus. <i>He <b>words</b> his request in a particularly ironic way.</i>
