Past Tense	decontextualized
Present Participle	decontextualizing
Past Participle	decontextualized

Conjugate Decontextualize

Decontextualize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **decontextualize** We **decontextualize**
You **decontextualize** You **decontextualize**
He/She/It **decontextualizes** They **decontextualize**

Decontextualize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am decontextualizing** We **are decontextualizing**
You **are decontextualizing** You **are decontextualizing**
He/She/It **is decontextualizing** They **are decontextualizing**

Decontextualize in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have decontextualized** We **have decontextualized**
You **have decontextualized** You **have decontextualized**
He/She/It **has decontextualized** They **have decontextualized**

Decontextualize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been decontextualizing** We **have been decontextualizing**
You **have been decontextualizing** You **have been decontextualizing**
He/She/It **has been decontextualizing** They **have been decontextualizing**

Decontextualize in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **decontextualized** We **decontextualized**
You **decontextualized** You **decontextualized**
He/She/It **decontextualized** They **decontextualized**

Decontextualize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was decontextualizing	We were decontextualizing
You were decontextualizing	You were decontextualizing
He/She/It was decontextualizing	They were decontextualizing

Decontextualize in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had decontextualized	We had decontextualized
You had decontextualized	You had decontextualized
He/She/It had decontextualized	They had decontextualized

Decontextualize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been decontextualizing	We had been decontextualizing
You had been decontextualizing	You had been decontextualizing
He/She/It had been decontextualizing	They had been decontextualizing

Decontextualize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will decontextualize	We will decontextualize
You will decontextualize	You will decontextualize
He/She/It will decontextualize	They will decontextualize

Decontextualize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be decontextualizing	We will be decontextualizing
You will be decontextualizing	You will be decontextualizing
He/She/It will be decontextualizing	They will be decontextualizing

Decontextualize in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have decontextualized

We will have decontextualized

You will have decontextualized

You will have decontextualized

He/She/It will have decontextualized **They will have decontextualized**

Decontextualize in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been decontextualizing

We will have been decontextualizing

You will have been decontextualizing

You will have been decontextualizing

He/She/It will have been decontextualizing **They will have been decontextualizing**
