Synonyms of "Decor" as a noun (9 Words)

<u>backdrop</u>	Scenery hung at back of stage. <i>The conference took place against a backdrop of increasing diplomatic activity.</i>
decoration	A thing that serves as an ornament. <i>He was awarded the highest Australian decoration.</i>
drop curtain	The act of dropping something.
flats	A musical notation indicating one half step lower than the note named.
furnishing	Denoting fabrics used for curtains or upholstery. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings.</i>
interior decoration	The region that is inside of something.
ornamentation	Something used to beautify. <i>A baroque chandelier with plasterwork ornamentation.</i>

- set** Any electronic equipment that receives or transmits radio or tv signals.
*They played two **sets** of tennis after dinner.*
- stage set** A section or portion of a journey or course.



Usage Examples of "Decor" as a noun

- *A decor that strained too hard to convey class.*
- *The decor revolves around a night-time street scene.*
- *Inside, the decor is elegant and traditional.*
