Deep-throat in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I deep-throat We deep-throat
You deep-throat You deep-throat
He/She/It deep-throats They deep-throat

Deep-throat in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am deep-throating We are deep-throating
You are deep-throating
He/She/It is deep-throating They are deep-throating

Deep-throat in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have deep-throated We have deep-throated You have deep-throated He/She/It has deep-throated They have deep-throated

Deep-throat in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been deep-throating

You have been deep-throating

You have been deep-throating

He/She/It has been deep-throating

They have been deep-throating

Deep-throat in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I deep-throated We deep-throated
You deep-throated You deep-throated
He/She/It deep-throated They deep-throated

Deep-throat in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was deep-throating We were deep-throating
You were deep-throating You were deep-throating
He/She/It was deep-throating They were deep-throating

Deep-throat in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had deep-throated We had deep-throated You had deep-throated He/She/It had deep-throated They had deep-throated

Deep-throat in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been deep-throating
You had been deep-throating
He/She/It had been deep-throating
They had been deep-throating

Deep-throat in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will deep-throat
You will deep-throat
He/She/It will deep-throat
They will deep-throat

Deep-throat in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be deep-throating
You will be deep-throating
He/She/It will be deep-throating
They will be deep-throating

Deep-throat in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have deep-throated
You will have deep-throated
He/She/It will have deep-throated
They will have deep-throated

Deep-throat in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been deep-throating
You will have been deep-throating
He/She/It will have been deep-throating
They will have been deep-throating
