## **The Forms of Defibrinate**

Infinitive	to defibrinate
Present Tense	defibrinate / defibrinates
Past Tense	defibrinated
Present Participle	defibrinating
Past Participle	defibrinated

# **Conjugate Defibrinate**

### **Defibrinate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>defibrinate</b>	We <b>defibrinate</b>
You <b>defibrinate</b>	You <b>defibrinate</b>
He/She/It <b>defibrinates</b>	They <b>defibrinate</b>

## **Defibrinate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am defibrinating	We are defibrinating
You <b>are defibrinating</b>	You <b>are defibrinating</b>
He/She/It is defibrinating	They are defibrinating

#### **Defibrinate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have defibrinated	We have defibrinated
You have defibrinated	You have defibrinated
He/She/It has defibrinated	They have defibrinated

## **Defibrinate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been defibrinating	We have been defibrinating
You <b>have been defibrinating</b>	You <b>have been defibrinating</b>
He/She/It has been defibrinating	They have been defibrinating

## **Defibrinate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I defibrinated	We <b>defibrinated</b>
You <b>defibrinated</b>	You <b>defibrinated</b>
He/She/It <b>defibrinated</b>	They <b>defibrinated</b>

#### **Defibrinate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was defibrinating	We were defibrinating
You <b>were defibrinating</b>	You were defibrinating
He/She/It was defibrinating	They were defibrinating

#### **Defibrinate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had defibrinated	We had defibrinated
You <b>had defibrinated</b>	You had defibrinated
He/She/It had defibrinated	They had defibrinated

## **Defibrinate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been defibrinating	We had been defibrinating
You <b>had been defibrinating</b>	You <b>had been defibrinating</b>
He/She/It had been defibrinating	They had been defibrinating

## **Defibrinate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will defibrinate	We <b>will defibrinate</b>
You <b>will defibrinate</b>	You <b>will defibrinate</b>
He/She/It will defibrinate	They will defibrinate

## **Defibrinate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be defibrinating	We will be defibrinating
You <b>will be defibrinating</b>	You <b>will be defibrinating</b>
He/She/It will be defibrinating	They will be defibrinating

## **Defibrinate in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have defibrinatedWe will have defibrinatedYou will have defibrinatedYou will have defibrinatedHe/She/It will have defibrinatedThey will have defibrinated

## **Defibrinate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been defibrinating	We <b>will have been defibrinating</b>
You <b>will have been defibrinating</b>	You will have been defibrinating
He/She/It will have been defibrinating	They will have been defibrinating
