## Dehumanize as a Verb

### Definitions of "Dehumanize" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “dehumanize” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Deprive of human qualities.*
- *Deprive of positive human qualities.*
- *Make mechanical or routine.*

### Synonyms of "Dehumanize" as a verb (6 Words)

<b>condition</b>	Of a beer become conditioned. <i>A product for <b>conditioning</b> leather.</i>
<b>dehumanise</b>	Make mechanical or routine.
<a href="#"><u>harden</u></a>	Cause to accept or become hardened to habituate. <i>Suspicion <b>hardened</b> into certainty.</i>
<b>season</b>	Make fit. <i>This trip will <b>season</b> even the hardest traveller.</i>
<a href="#"><u>temper</u></a>	Make more temperate acceptable or suitable by adding something else. <i>For a shiny sheen to the chocolate coating I recommend <b>tempering</b> the chocolate first.</i>

**toughen**

Make or become stronger or more resilient.

*This experience will **toughen** her.*

**Usage Examples of "Dehumanize" as a verb**

- *Brutal management methods and fear can dehumanize people.*
- *Life in poverty has dehumanized them.*
