Dehumanize as a Verb

Definitions of "Dehumanize" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “dehumanize” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Deprive of human qualities.*
- *Deprive of positive human qualities.*
- *Make mechanical or routine.*

Synonyms of "Dehumanize" as a verb (6 Words)

condition	Of a beer become conditioned. <i>A product for conditioning leather.</i>
dehumanise	Make mechanical or routine.
harden	Cause to accept or become hardened to habituate. <i>Suspicion hardened into certainty.</i>
season	Make fit. <i>This trip will season even the hardest traveller.</i>
temper	Make more temperate acceptable or suitable by adding something else. <i>For a shiny sheen to the chocolate coating I recommend tempering the chocolate first.</i>

toughen Make or become stronger or more resilient.
*This experience will **toughen** her.*

Usage Examples of "Dehumanize" as a verb

- *Brutal management methods and fear can dehumanize people.*
- *Life in poverty has dehumanized them.*
