dehumanise Make mechanical or routine.

harden Cause to accept or become hardened to habituate.

Suspicion **harden**ed into certainty.

Make fit.

This trip will **season** even the hardiest traveller.

Make more temperate acceptable or suitable by adding something else.

temper For a shiny sheen to the chocolate coating I recommend **temper**ing the

chocolate first.



toughen

Make or become stronger or more resilient.

This experience will **toughen** her.
