#### **Delay in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

## **Delay in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am delaying	We <b>are delaying</b>
You <b>are delaying</b>	You <b>are delaying</b>
He/She/It is delaying	They are delaying

#### **Delay in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have delayed	We have delayed
You have delayed	You have delayed
He/She/It has delayed	They have delayed

#### **Delay in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been delaying	We have been delaying
You <b>have been delaying</b>	You have been delaying
He/She/It has been delaying	They have been delaying

#### **Delay in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I delayed	We <b>delayed</b>
You <b>delayed</b>	You <b>delayed</b>
He/She/It <b>delayed</b>	They <b>delayed</b>

#### **Delay in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was delaying	We <b>were delaying</b>
You <b>were delaying</b>	You were delaying
He/She/It was delaying	They were delaying

## **Delay in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had delayed	We had delayed
You had delayed	You had delayed
He/She/It had delayed	They had delayed

## **Delay in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been delaying	We had been delaying
You <b>had been delaying</b>	You had been delaying
He/She/It had been delaying	They had been delaying

## **Delay in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will delay	We <b>will delay</b>
You <b>will delay</b>	You <b>will delay</b>
He/She/It will delay	They will delay

## **Delay in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be delaying	We <b>will be delaying</b>
You <b>will be delaying</b>	You <b>will be delaying</b>
He/She/It will be delaying	They will be delaying

## **Delay in Future Perfect Tense**

## **Delay in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been delaying	We <b>will have been delaying</b>
You <b>will have been delaying</b>	You <b>will have been delaying</b>
He/She/It will have been delaying	They will have been delaying
