Conjugate Delegitimise

Delegitimise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I delegitimise
You delegitimise
He/She/It delegitimises They delegitimise

Delegitimise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am delegitimising We are delegitimising
You are delegitimising
He/She/It is delegitimising They are delegitimising

Delegitimise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have delegitimised We have delegitimised You have delegitimised He/She/It has delegitimised They have delegitimised

Delegitimise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been delegitimising
You have been delegitimising
You have been delegitimising
He/She/It has been delegitimising
They have been delegitimising

Delegitimise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I delegitimised We delegitimised
You delegitimised You delegitimised
He/She/It delegitimised They delegitimised

Delegitimise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was delegitimising We were delegitimising
You were delegitimising
He/She/It was delegitimising They were delegitimising

Delegitimise in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had delegitimised We had delegitimised
You had delegitimised You had delegitimised
He/She/It had delegitimised They had delegitimised

Delegitimise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been delegitimising
You had been delegitimising
He/She/It had been delegitimising
They had been delegitimising

Delegitimise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will delegitimise
You will delegitimise
He/She/It will delegitimise
They will delegitimise

Delegitimise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be delegitimising
You will be delegitimising
He/She/It will be delegitimising
They will be delegitimising

Delegitimise in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have delegitimised
You will have delegitimised
He/She/It will have delegitimised
They will have delegitimised

Delegitimise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been delegitimising
You will have been delegitimising
He/She/It will have been delegitimising
They will have been delegitimising
