draw	Represent by making a drawing of as with a pencil chalk etc on a surface. <i>Draw the curtains.</i>
limn	Suffuse or highlight (something) with a bright colour or light. <i>Miss Read limns a gentler world in her novels.</i>
line	Be in line with form a line along. <i>Sorrow had lined his face.</i>

explicitly	In a clear and detailed manner, leaving no room for confusion or doubt. <i>The essay should state explicitly how the facts support the thesis.</i>
expound	State. <i>He was expounding a powerful argument.</i>
narrative	A spoken or written account of connected events; a story. <i>A narrative poem.</i>
outline	Draw up an outline or sketch for something. <i>The chalked outline of a human body.</i>
portray	Portray in words. <i>He chose Trevor Howard to portray Captain Bligh.</i>
precis	Make a precis of a text or speech.
profile	Represent in profile by drawing or painting. <i>In soft rocks a profile drawn normally to the beach would show a concave form comparable with the long profile of a river.</i>
prospectus	A formal written offer to sell securities (filed with the SEC) that sets forth a plan for a (proposed) business enterprise. <i>A prospectus should contain the facts that an investor needs to make an informed decision.</i>
quote	Put quote marks around. <i>Use double quotes around precise phrases you wish to search for.</i>
recapitulate	Summarize and state again the main points of. <i>Let s recapitulate the main ideas.</i>
resume	Take or put on again. <i>He sipped at the glass of water and then resumed.</i>
scribble	A piece of writing or a picture produced carelessly or hurriedly. <i>He took the clipboard and scribbled something illegible.</i>

<u>sketch</u>	Make a sketch of. <i>Jeanne sketched and painted whenever she had the time.</i>
<u>specify</u>	Specify as a condition or requirement in a contract or agreement make an express demand or provision in an agreement. <i>Specify the parameters.</i>
stipulate	Demand or specify (a requirement), typically as part of an agreement. <i>They stipulated to release all the prisoners.</i>
<u>summarize</u>	Be a summary of. <i>These results can be summarized in the following table.</i>
summary	(of a judicial process) conducted without the customary legal formalities. <i>A summary formulation of a wide ranging subject.</i>
<u>synopsis</u>	A sketchy summary of the main points of an argument or theory. <i>A synopsis of the insurance cover provided is set out below.</i>
transcript	A length of RNA or DNA that has been transcribed respectively from a DNA or RNA template. <i>You can obtain a transcript of this radio program by sending a self addressed envelope to the station.</i>
<u>vignette</u>	Produce a photograph in the style of a vignette by softening or shading away the edges of the subject. <i>A classic vignette of embassy life.</i>
