## Associations of "Deliverable" (30 Words)

<b>address</b>	Access or locate by address. <i>His <b>address</b> was abrupt and unceremonious.</i>
<b>asset</b>	An item of property owned by a person or company, regarded as having value and available to meet debts, commitments, or legacies. <i>The school is an <b>asset</b> to the community.</i>
<b><a href="#">belonging</a></b>	An affinity for a place or situation. <i>We feel a real sense of <b>belonging</b>.</i>
<b>beneficial</b>	Relating to rights to the use or benefit of property, other than legal title. <i>The <b>beneficial</b> effect on the economy.</i>
<b>benefit</b>	Derive a benefit from. <i>For the <b>benefit</b> of all.</i>
<b>commodity</b>	A useful or valuable thing. <i><b>Commodity</b> markets.</i>
<b>externalize</b>	Make external or objective, or give reality to. <i>Language <b>externalizes</b> our thoughts.</i>
<b>forfeited</b>	Surrendered as a penalty.
<b>fungible</b>	Of goods or commodities; freely exchangeable for or replaceable by another of like nature or kind in the satisfaction of an obligation. <i>It is by no means the world's only <b>fungible</b> commodity.</i>
<b>healthiness</b>	The state of being vigorous and free from bodily or mental disease.
<b>hemorrhage</b>	Lose blood from one's body.
<b>mail</b>	A vehicle such as a train carrying mail. <i>You've got <b>mail</b>.</i>
<b>merchandise</b>	Trade or traffic in (something), especially inappropriately. <i>The official <b>merchandise</b> for the film.</i>

<b>misappropriate</b>	Dishonestly or unfairly take (something, especially money, belonging to another) for one's own use. <i>The report revealed that department officials had <b>misappropriated</b> funds.</i>
<b>mislaid</b>	Place (something) where one cannot find it again. <i>I seem to have <b>mislaid</b> my car keys.</i>
<b>objectify</b>	Make impersonal or present as an object. <i>Good poetry <b>objectifies</b> feeling.</i>
<b>owned</b>	Having an owner; often used in combination. <i>State <b>owned</b> railways.</i>
<b>payee</b>	A person to whom money is paid.
<b>post</b>	A starting post or winning post. <i>The newspaper <b>posted</b> him in Timbuktu.</i>
<b>product</b>	A person whose character and identity have been formed by a particular period or situation. <i>Waste <b>products</b>.</i>
<b>property</b>	Shares or investments in property. <i>The <b>property</b> of heat to expand metal at uniform rates.</i>
<b>proprietorship</b>	An unincorporated business owned by a single person who is responsible for its liabilities and entitled to its profits. <i>Plenty of new firms especially sole <b>proprietorships</b> don't make money in their first few years of operation.</i>
<b>resource</b>	Provide with resources. <i>The database could be used as a reference and teaching <b>resource</b>.</i>
<b>sale</b>	A period during which a shop or dealer sells goods at reduced prices. <i>We withdrew it from <b>sale</b>.</i>
<b>squander</b>	Allow (an opportunity) to pass or be lost. <i>You <b>squandered</b> the opportunity to get an advanced degree.</i>
<b>stock</b>	Supply with livestock. <i>It was a fine gun which he forged <b>stocked</b> and completed himself.</i>
<b>thing</b>	Anything used for emphasis. <i>Here's the <b>thing</b> this is a story not a piece of hard news.</i>
<b>trading</b>	The action or activity of buying and selling goods and services. <i><b>Trading</b> profits leapt.</i>
<b>value</b>	Fix or determine the value of; assign a value to. <i><b>Value</b> the jewelry and art work in the estate.</i>
