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## Associations of "Deliverables" (30 Words)

<b>address</b>	Address or apply oneself to something direct one's efforts towards something such as a question. <i>I <b>addressed</b> my letter to him personally.</i>
<b>asset</b>	A useful or valuable quality. <i>The school is an <b>asset</b> to the community.</i>
<b>belonging</b>	Happiness felt in a secure relationship. <i>With his classmates he felt a sense of <b>belonging</b>.</i>
<b>beneficial</b>	Relating to rights to the use or benefit of property, other than legal title. <i>The process was <b>beneficial</b> to both supplier and customer.</i>
<b>benefit</b>	Derive a benefit from. <i>The changes are of <b>benefit</b> to commerce.</i>
<b>commodity</b>	A raw material or primary agricultural product that can be bought and sold, such as copper or coffee. <i>Water is a precious <b>commodity</b>.</i>
<b>externalize</b>	Project (a mental image or process) on to a figure outside oneself. <i>Elements of the internal construction were <b>externalized</b> on to the facade.</i>
<b>forfeited</b>	Surrendered as a penalty.
<b>fungible</b>	Of goods or commodities; freely exchangeable for or replaceable by another of like nature or kind in the satisfaction of an obligation. <i>It is by no means the world's only <b>fungible</b> commodity.</i>
<b>healthiness</b>	The state of being vigorous and free from bodily or mental disease.
<b>hemorrhage</b>	Lose blood from one's body.
<b>mail</b>	Send someone email. <i>He works for the United States <b>mail</b> service.</i>
<b>merchandise</b>	Engage in the trade of. <i>Shops which offered an astonishing range of <b>merchandise</b>.</i>

<b>misappropriate</b>	Dishonestly or unfairly take (something, especially money, belonging to another) for one's own use. <i>The report revealed that department officials had <b>misappropriated</b> funds.</i>
<b>mislaid</b>	Place (something) where one cannot find it again. <i>I seem to have <b>mislaid</b> my car keys.</i>
<b>objectify</b>	Express (something abstract) in a concrete form. <i>A deeply sexist attitude that <b>objectifies</b> women.</i>
<b>owned</b>	Having an owner; often used in combination. <i>State <b>owned</b> railways.</i>
<b>payee</b>	A person to whom money is paid or is to be paid, especially the person to whom a cheque is made payable.
<b>post</b>	A goalpost. <i>In England they call mail the <b>post</b>.</i>
<b>product</b>	A person whose character and identity have been formed by a particular period or situation. <i>That store offers a variety of <b>products</b>.</i>
<b>property</b>	Shares or investments in property. <i>The stolen <b>property</b> was not recovered.</i>
<b>proprietorship</b>	An unincorporated business owned by a single person who is responsible for its liabilities and entitled to its profits. <i>The company was established in 1912 and is still under the <b>proprietorship</b> of the same family.</i>
<b>resource</b>	The ability to deal resourcefully with unusual problems. <i>Local authorities complained that they lacked <b>resources</b>.</i>
<b>sale</b>	The activity or business of selling products. <i>They tried to boost <b>sales</b>.</i>
<b>squander</b>	Allow (an opportunity) to pass or be lost. <i>You <b>squandered</b> the opportunity to get an advanced degree.</i>
<b>stock</b>	Fit a rifle or other firearm with a stock. <i>The fat can be used as soap <b>stock</b>.</i>
<b>thing</b>	Used to express one's disapproval of or contempt for something. <i>It is a remarkable <b>thing</b>.</i>
<b>trading</b>	Buying or selling securities or commodities. <i><b>Trading</b> profits leapt.</i>
<b>value</b>	Fix or determine the value of; assign a value to. <i>He has old-fashioned <b>values</b>.</i>
