<u>burrow</u>	Dig into or through something solid. <b>Burrow</b> through the forest.
colliery	A workplace consisting of a coal mine plus all the buildings and equipment connected with it.
coxswain	The senior petty officer in a small ship or submarine in the Royal Navy.
dig	An act or spell of digging. <b>Dig</b> out a channel.
disinter	Dig up (something that has been buried, especially a corpse. <i>He has <b>disinter</b>red an important collection of writings.</i>
dug	An udder or breast or teat.
excavate	Dig out material from (the ground. The cheapest way of doing this was to <b>excavate</b> a long trench.
excavation	The act of digging. The methods of <b>excavation</b> have to be extremely rigorous.
exhume	Dig out (something buried, especially a corpse) from the ground. The bodies were <b>exhume</b> d on the orders of a judge.
<u>furrow</u>	Cut a furrow into a columns. A look of concern <b>furrow</b> ed his brow.
<u>gold</u>	Coins made of gold. He proved to be a rabid seeker for <b>gold</b> and power.
granite	Something having the quality of granite unyielding firmness. <i>A man with <b>granite</b> determination.</i>



gravel	A mixture of gravel with coarse sand used for paths and roads and as an aggregate. Steps lead down from the terrace to a <b>gravel</b> led path.
groove	A long narrow furrow cut either by a natural process such as erosion or by a tool as e g a groove in a phonograph record. His thoughts were slipping into a familiar <b>groove</b> .
harrow	Draw a harrow over land. Todd could take it whereas I m <b>harrow</b> ed by it.
hole	Hit the ball into a hole. Stephen lost the first three <b>hole</b> s to Eric.
inhume	Bury. No hand his bones shall gather or <b>inhume</b> .
investigate	Investigate scientifically. Everyone with a possible interest in your brother s death must be thoroughly <b>investigate</b> d.
<u>mine</u>	Excavation in the earth from which ores and minerals are extracted. <i>The Vietnamese mined Cambodia.</i>
<u>pit</u>	Sink in or contract so as to form a pit or hollow. A bear <b>pit</b> .
plow	Move in a way resembling that of a plow cutting into or going through the soil. Farmer Jones <b>plow</b> ed his east field last week.
quarry	Extract stone or other materials from a quarry. A limestone <b>quarry</b> .
<u>scoop</u>	A quantity taken up by a scoop. What s the <b>scoop</b> old timer.
seed	Give a competitor the status of seed in a tournament. After <b>seed</b> ing forage into the duff they now have grassland mixed with mature forest.
shovel	Dig with or as if with a shovel. <b>Shovel</b> sand.
tiller	Grow shoots in the form of stools or tillers.
turnover	The rate at which employees leave a workforce and are replaced. The team were sitting on their lead and taking care to avoid <b>turnover</b> s.
<u>underground</u>	An underground railway especially the one in London. <b>Underground</b> caverns.
