antenatal	Occurring or existing before birth. <i>Antenatal care.</i>
aunt	The sister of your father or mother; the wife of your uncle. <i>She was brought up by her aunt and uncle.</i>
born	British nuclear physicist born in Germany honored for his contributions to quantum mechanics 1882 1970. <i>She was born in Aberdeen.</i>
brother	A (male) fellow Christian. <i>My brother still lives with our parents.</i>
cousin	A person of a kindred race or nation. <i>She s a distant cousin.</i>
dad	One’s father. <i>His dad was with him.</i>
daddy	The oldest, best, or biggest example of something. <i>It s you who s calling the shots now you re the daddy.</i>
daughter	A thing personified as a daughter in relation to its origin or source. <i>Italian the eldest daughter of ancient Latin.</i>
descendants	All of the offspring of a given progenitor.
family	People descended from a common ancestor. <i>A family newspaper.</i>
father	Treat with the protective care associated with a father. <i>Pray for me father.</i>
grandchild	A child of your son or daughter.
grandfather	The father of your father or mother. <i>Freud is often called the grandfather of psychoanalysis.</i>
grandparent	A parent of your father or mother. <i>It must be a great blessing to have Chloe s grandparents living nearby.</i>

maternal	(of feelings) typical of a caring mother; motherly. <i>Warm maternal affection for her guest.</i>
maternity	The kinship relation between an offspring and the mother. <i>She is not a woman with an interest in maternity.</i>
mommy	Informal terms for a mother.
nephew	A son of your brother or sister.
niece	A daughter of your brother or sister.
offspring	A person's child or children. <i>She was the mother of many offspring.</i>
parent	Be or act as a parent to a child. <i>All children are special to those who parent them.</i>
parental	Relating to an animal or plant from which new ones are derived. <i>Parental guidance.</i>
paternal	Relating to or characteristic of or befitting a parent. <i>A paternal aunt.</i>
paternity	The kinship relation between an offspring and the father. <i>He refused to admit paternity of the child.</i>
pregnancy	The state of being pregnant; the period from conception to birth when a woman carries a developing fetus in her uterus. <i>A straightforward pregnancy.</i>
progeny	A descendant or the descendants of a person, animal, or plant; offspring. <i>Shorthorn cattle are highly effective in bestowing their characteristics on their progeny.</i>
sibling	A person's brother or sister.
sister	A member of a religious order of women. <i>None of her sisters would betray her.</i>
sisterhood	The feeling of kinship with and closeness to a group of women or all women. <i>Much of sisterhood is about sharing lipsticks.</i>
uncle	The brother of one's father or mother or the husband of one's aunt. <i>He played uncle to lonely students.</i>
