Conjugate Denominate

Denominate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I denominate
You denominate
He/She/It denominates They denominate

Denominate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am denominating We are denominating
You are denominating
He/She/It is denominating They are denominating

Denominate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have denominated We have denominated You have denominated You have denominated He/She/It has denominated They have denominated

Denominate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been denominating
You have been denominating
He/She/It has been denominating
They have been denominating

Denominate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I denominated We denominated
You denominated You denominated
He/She/It denominated They denominated

Denominate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was denominating We were denominating
You were denominating
He/She/It was denominating They were denominating

Denominate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had denominated We had denominated You had denominated He/She/It had denominated They had denominated

Denominate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been denominating
You had been denominating
You had been denominating
He/She/It had been denominating
They had been denominating

Denominate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will denominate
You will denominate
He/She/It will denominate
They will denominate

Denominate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be denominating
You will be denominating
He/She/It will be denominating
They will be denominating

Denominate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have denominated We will have denominated You will have denominated He/She/It will have denominated They will have denominated

Denominate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been denominating
You will have been denominating
He/She/It will have been denominating
They will have been denominating
