Definitions of "Density" as a noun

- *The degree of compactness of a substance.*
- *The opacity of a photographic image.*
- *A measure of the amount of information on a storage medium.*
- *The amount per unit size.*
- *The quantity of mass per unit volume of a substance.*
- *The spatial property of being crowded together.*
- *The quantity of people or things in a given area or space.*



Synonyms of "Density" as a noun (11 Words)

bulk

A large mass or shape.

*He moved quickly in spite of his **bulk**.*

compactness

Conciseness of expression in speech or writing.

*The soil's **compactness** makes root penetration difficult.*

concentration

Strengthening the concentration as of a solute in a mixture by removing diluting material.

***Concentration** on the needs of the young can mean that the elderly are forgotten.*

denseness

The spatial property of being crowded together.

mass

A body of matter without definite shape.

*Separate the warriors from the **mass**.*

solidity

The quality of being solid and reliable financially or factually or morally.

*He exuded an aura of reassuring **solidity**.*

solidness	The consistency of a solid. <i>The solidness of her faith gave her enduring hope.</i>
substance	Considerable capital (wealth or income). <i>A steel tube coated with a waxy substance.</i>
thickness	The location of something surrounded by other things. <i>The gateway is several feet in thickness.</i>
tightness	A tight feeling in some part of the body. <i>The extreme tightness in today's oil markets.</i>
<u>weight</u>	Blocks or discs of metal or other heavy material used in weightlifting or weight training. <i>His opinion carries great weight.</i>



Usage Examples of "Density" as a noun

- A density of 10,000 per square mile.
- Areas of low population density.
- A low-density floppy disk.
- A reduction in bone density.



Associations of "Density" (30 Words)

absorbed	Having one's attention fully engaged; greatly interested. <i>The stones warm slowly throughout the day then radiate absorbed heat at night.</i>
census	Conduct a census. <i>A traffic census.</i>
<u>center</u>	Basketball the person who plays center on a basketball team. <i>In most people the speech center is in the left hemisphere.</i>
<u>centered</u>	Being or placed in the center.
centimeter	A metric unit of length equal to one hundredth of a meter.
<u>circle</u>	Move in circles. <i>He calculated the circumference of the circle.</i>
<u>city</u>	A town created a city by charter and usually containing a cathedral. <i>The city raised the tax rate.</i>
<u>concentration</u>	Strengthening the concentration as of a solute in a mixture by removing diluting material. <i>The gas can collect in dangerous concentrations.</i>
<u>convergence</u>	The process or state of converging. <i>The convergence of lines in the distance.</i>
cube	Raise a number or value to its cube. <i>What is the surface area of a 2 cm cube.</i>
cubic	A cubic equation or a curve described by one. <i>A cubic room.</i>
denseness	The spatial property of being crowded together.
duplex	Change into a duplex. <i>Duplex system.</i>
dyne	A unit of force that, acting on a mass of one gram, increases its velocity by one centimetre per second every second along the direction that it acts.
<u>hierarchy</u>	The clergy of the Catholic Church or of an episcopal Church. <i>The Roman Catholic hierarchy in Romania.</i>
<u>housing</u>	Structures collectively in which people are housed. <i>The sector offers housing to the poorest.</i>
<u>immersion</u>	(astronomy) the disappearance of a celestial body prior to an eclipse. <i>A week s immersion in the culinary heritage of Puglia.</i>
impurity	Worthless or dangerous material that should be removed. <i>A struggle to rid the soul of sin and impurity.</i>

<u>intensive</u>	An intensive adjective adverb or particle an intensifier. <i>Research intensive.</i>
meter	Measure with a meter. <i>Meter the flow of water.</i>
organizational	Relating to the action of organizing something. <i>Organizational heads.</i>
outskirts	Outlying areas (as of a city or town). <i>He built a new factory on the outskirts of Birmingham.</i>
packet	The contents of a packet. <i>One man was fined 25 for dropping a crisp packet from his car window.</i>
pentameter	A verse line having five metrical feet.
polyurethane	Coat or protect with polyurethane. <i>Five coats of polyurethane.</i>
<u>population</u>	The act of populating (causing to live in a place). <i>They hired hunters to keep down the deer population.</i>
populous	Densely populated. <i>The populous city of Shanghai.</i>
suburban	Of or characteristic of a suburb. <i>Suburban life.</i>
<u>unit</u>	The smallest measure of investment in a unit trust. <i>Large areas of land made up of smaller units.</i>
urban	Denoting or relating to popular dance music associated with black performers. <i>Urban property owners.</i>
