- *A measure of the amount of information on a storage medium.*
- *The amount per unit size.*
- *The quantity of mass per unit volume of a substance.*
- *The spatial property of being crowded together.*
- *The quantity of people or things in a given area or space.*



## Synonyms of "Density" as a noun (11 Words)

### **bulk**

A large mass or shape.

*He moved quickly in spite of his **bulk**.*

### **compactness**

Conciseness of expression in speech or writing.

*The soil's **compactness** makes root penetration difficult.*

### **concentration**

Strengthening the concentration as of a solute in a mixture by removing diluting material.

***Concentration** on the needs of the young can mean that the elderly are forgotten.*

### **denseness**

The spatial property of being crowded together.

### **mass**

A body of matter without definite shape.

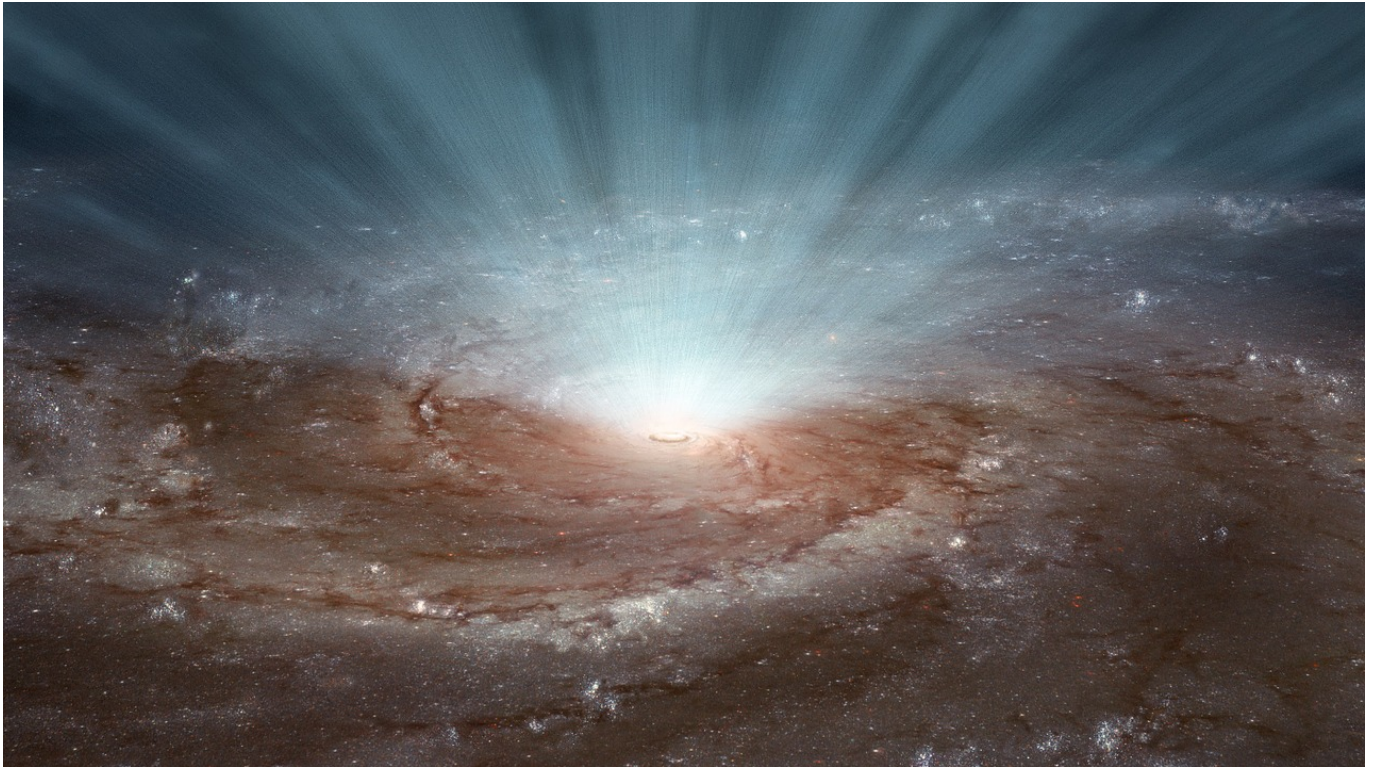
*Separate the warriors from the **mass**.*

### **solidity**

The quality of being solid and reliable financially or factually or morally.

*He exuded an aura of reassuring **solidity**.*

<b>solidness</b>	The consistency of a solid. <i>The <b>solidness</b> of her faith gave her enduring hope.</i>
<b>substance</b>	Considerable capital (wealth or income). <i>A steel tube coated with a waxy <b>substance</b>.</i>
<b>thickness</b>	The location of something surrounded by other things. <i>The gateway is several feet in <b>thickness</b>.</i>
<b>tightness</b>	A tight feeling in some part of the body. <i>The extreme <b>tightness</b> in today's oil markets.</i>
<b><u>weight</u></b>	Blocks or discs of metal or other heavy material used in weightlifting or weight training. <i>His opinion carries great <b>weight</b>.</i>



## Usage Examples of "Density" as a noun

- A density of 10,000 per square mile.
- Areas of low population density.
- A low-density floppy disk.
- A reduction in bone density.

<b>absorbed</b>	Having one's attention fully engaged; greatly interested. <i>The stones warm slowly throughout the day then radiate <b>absorbed</b> heat at night.</i>
<b>census</b>	Conduct a census. <i>A traffic <b>census</b>.</i>
<u><a href="#">center</a></u>	Basketball the person who plays center on a basketball team. <i>In most people the speech <b>center</b> is in the left hemisphere.</i>
<u><a href="#">centered</a></u>	Being or placed in the center.
<b>centimeter</b>	A metric unit of length equal to one hundredth of a meter.
<u><a href="#">circle</a></u>	Move in circles. <i>He calculated the circumference of the <b>circle</b>.</i>
<u><a href="#">city</a></u>	A town created a city by charter and usually containing a cathedral. <i>The <b>city</b> raised the tax rate.</i>
<u><a href="#">concentration</a></u>	Strengthening the concentration as of a solute in a mixture by removing diluting material. <i>The gas can collect in dangerous <b>concentrations</b>.</i>
<u><a href="#">convergence</a></u>	The process or state of converging. <i>The <b>convergence</b> of lines in the distance.</i>
<b>cube</b>	Raise a number or value to its cube. <i>What is the surface area of a 2 cm <b>cube</b>.</i>
<b>cubic</b>	A cubic equation or a curve described by one. <i>A <b>cubic</b> room.</i>
<b>denseness</b>	The spatial property of being crowded together.
<b>duplex</b>	Change into a duplex. <i><b>Duplex</b> system.</i>
<b>dyne</b>	A unit of force that, acting on a mass of one gram, increases its velocity by one centimetre per second every second along the direction that it acts.
<u><a href="#">hierarchy</a></u>	The clergy of the Catholic Church or of an episcopal Church. <i>The Roman Catholic <b>hierarchy</b> in Romania.</i>
<u><a href="#">housing</a></u>	Structures collectively in which people are housed. <i>The sector offers <b>housing</b> to the poorest.</i>
<u><a href="#">immersion</a></u>	(astronomy) the disappearance of a celestial body prior to an eclipse. <i>A week s <b>immersion</b> in the culinary heritage of Puglia.</i>
<b>impurity</b>	Worthless or dangerous material that should be removed. <i>A struggle to rid the soul of sin and <b>impurity</b>.</i>

<b><u>intensive</u></b>	An intensive adjective adverb or particle an intensifier. <i>Research <b>intensive</b>.</i>
<b>meter</b>	Measure with a meter. <i><b>Meter</b> the flow of water.</i>
<b>organizational</b>	Relating to the action of organizing something. <i><b>Organizational</b> heads.</i>
<b>outskirts</b>	Outlying areas (as of a city or town). <i>He built a new factory on the <b>outskirts</b> of Birmingham.</i>
<b>packet</b>	The contents of a packet. <i>One man was fined 25 for dropping a crisp <b>packet</b> from his car window.</i>
<b>pentameter</b>	A verse line having five metrical feet.
<b>polyurethane</b>	Coat or protect with polyurethane. <i>Five coats of <b>polyurethane</b>.</i>
<b><u>population</u></b>	The act of populating (causing to live in a place). <i>They hired hunters to keep down the deer <b>population</b>.</i>
<b>populous</b>	Densely populated. <i>The <b>populous</b> city of Shanghai.</i>
<b>suburban</b>	Of or characteristic of a suburb. <i><b>Suburban</b> life.</i>
<b><u>unit</u></b>	The smallest measure of investment in a unit trust. <i>Large areas of land made up of smaller <b>units</b>.</i>
<b>urban</b>	Denoting or relating to popular dance music associated with black performers. <i><b>Urban</b> property owners.</i>
