The Forms of Depaint

Infinitive	to depaint
Present Tense	depaint / depaints
Past Tense	depainted
Present Participle	depainting
Past Participle	depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten

Conjugate Depaint

Depaint in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I depaint	We depaint
You depaint	You depaint
He/She/It depaints	They depaint

Depaint in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am depainting	We are depainting
You are depainting	You are depainting
He/She/It is depainting	They are depainting

Depaint in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have depainted or (archaic and rare)	We have depainted or (archaic and rare)
depainten	depainten
You have depainted or (archaic and rare)	You have depainted or (archaic and rare)
depainten	depainten
He/She/It has depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten	They have depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten

Depaint in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been depainting	We have been depainting
You have been depainting	You have been depainting
He/She/It has been depainting	They have been depainting

Depaint in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I depainted	We depainted
You depainted	You depainted
He/She/It depainted	They depainted



Depaint in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was depainting	We were depainting
You were depainting	You were depainting
He/She/It was depainting	They were depainting

Depaint in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had depainted or (archaic and rare)	We had depainted or (archaic and rare)
depainten	depainten
You had depainted or (archaic and rare)	You had depainted or (archaic and rare)
depainten	depainten
He/She/It had depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten	They had depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten

Depaint in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been depainting	We had been depainting
You had been depainting	You had been depainting
He/She/It had been depainting	They had been depainting

Depaint in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will depaint	We will depaint
You will depaint	You will depaint
He/She/It will depaint	They will depaint

Depaint in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be depainting	We will be depainting
You will be depainting	You will be depainting



SingularPluralHe/She/It will be depainting They will be depainting

Depaint in Future Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten	We will have depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten
You will have depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten	You will have depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten
He/She/It will have depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten	They will have depainted or (archaic and rare) depainten

Depaint in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been depainting	We will have been depainting
You will have been depainting	You will have been depainting
He/She/It will have been depainting	They will have been depainting
