Definitions of "Designer" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “designer” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A person who plans the look or workings of something prior to it being made, by preparing drawings or plans.*
- *A person who devises plots or intrigues.*
- *A person who specializes in interior design.*
- *A person who specializes in designing architectural interiors and their furnishings.*
- *Someone who designs clothing.*
- *Someone who creates plans to be used in making something (such as buildings.*
- *Someone who specializes in graphic design.*



Synonyms of "Designer" as a noun (19 Words)

architect

A person who designs hardware, software, or networking applications and services of a specified type for a business or other organization.
*The great Norman **architect** of Durham Cathedral.*

artificer

A skilled craftsman or inventor.

author

The writings produced by a particular author.
*He is the **author** of several books on the subject.*

clothes designer Clothing in general.

costumier

Someone who designs or supplies costumes (as for a play or masquerade).
*A theatrical **costumier**.*

couturier

A fashion designer who manufactures and sells clothes that have been tailored to a client's specific requirements and measurements.
*Clothes of luxurious fabrics cut by top **couturiers** to fit them to perfection.*

<u>creator</u>	Used as a name for God. <i>Water the creator of climate and weather.</i>
deviser	A will disposing of real property.
dressmaker	Someone who makes or mends dresses.
fabricator	Someone who tells lies.
fashion designer	Consumer goods (especially clothing) in the current mode.
graphic designer	An image that is generated by a computer.
interior designer	The inner or enclosed surface of something.
intriguer	A person who devises plots or intrigues.
<u>inventor</u>	A person who invented a particular process or device or who invents things as an occupation.
originator	A person who creates or initiates something. <i>Wegener was the originator of the theory of continental drift.</i>
planner	A person who controls or plans urban development. <i>Economic planners.</i>
producer	A person or thing that makes or causes something. <i>This microorganism is a producer of disease.</i>
tailor	A person whose occupation is making fitted clothes such as suits, trousers, and jackets to fit individual customers.



Usage Examples of "Designer" as a noun

- *He's one of the world's leading car designers.*
- *He is believed to be the principal designer of the terrorist bombing attack.*

actress	A woman who behaves in a way that is not genuine. <i>She is one of the great actresses of her generation.</i>
architect	A person who is responsible for inventing or realizing a particular idea or project. <i>We are seeking an experienced software architect to join our scientific computing team.</i>
architecture	The conceptual structure and logical organization of a computer or computer-based system. <i>Schools of architecture and design.</i>
artist	A person skilled at a particular task or occupation. <i>Rip off artists.</i>
atelier	A studio especially for an artist or designer.
blueprint	Make a blueprint of. <i>The scheme was a blueprint for future development programmes.</i>
builder	A person who constructs something by putting parts or material together. <i>A boatbuilder.</i>

<u>carpenter</u>	Work as a carpenter. <i>The rails were carpentered very skilfully.</i>
<u>celebrity</u>	A widely known person. <i>His prestige and celebrity grew.</i>
clothes	Bedclothes. <i>He stripped off his clothes.</i>
<u>coiffure</u>	A person's hairstyle. <i>Diana s intricately braided coiffure.</i>
coloring	The act or process of changing the color of something.
draw	Obtain or withdraw money from a bank or other source. <i>He met them with a drawn sword.</i>
<u>engineer</u>	Design as an engineer. <i>She engineered another meeting with him.</i>
engraver	A printmaker who prints from an engraved printing plate. <i>A laser engraver is used for some fine details.</i>
goggle	Close-fitting glasses with side shields, for protecting the eyes from glare, dust, water, etc. <i>Their goggle mesmerizes even fishmongers.</i>
illustrator	A person who draws or creates pictures for magazines, books, advertising, etc.
lithograph	Print by lithography. <i>He lithographed the diploma leaving only two blanks one for the name of the recipient and the other for the date.</i>
modernist	Of or associated with modernism, especially in the arts. <i>James Joyce and other 20th century modernists.</i>
painter	A person whose job is painting buildings. <i>A self employed painter and decorator.</i>
panther	A leopard in the black color phase.
<u>portrait</u>	Any likeness of a person, in any medium. <i>The photographer made excellent portraits.</i>
redesign	The action or process of redesigning something. <i>The front seats have been redesigned.</i>
remodel	Shape (a figure or object) again or differently. <i>She remodelled the head with careful fingers.</i>
sculptor	An artist who makes sculptures.
silversmith	A person who makes silver articles.
sunglasses	Glasses tinted to protect the eyes from sunlight or glare.

supermodel A fashion model who has attained the status of a celebrity.

wear The wearing of something or the state of being worn as clothing.
*You need to make a deduction for **wear** and tear on all your belongings.*

yawn Utter a yawn as from lack of oxygen or when one is tired.
*He began **yawning** and looking at his watch.*
