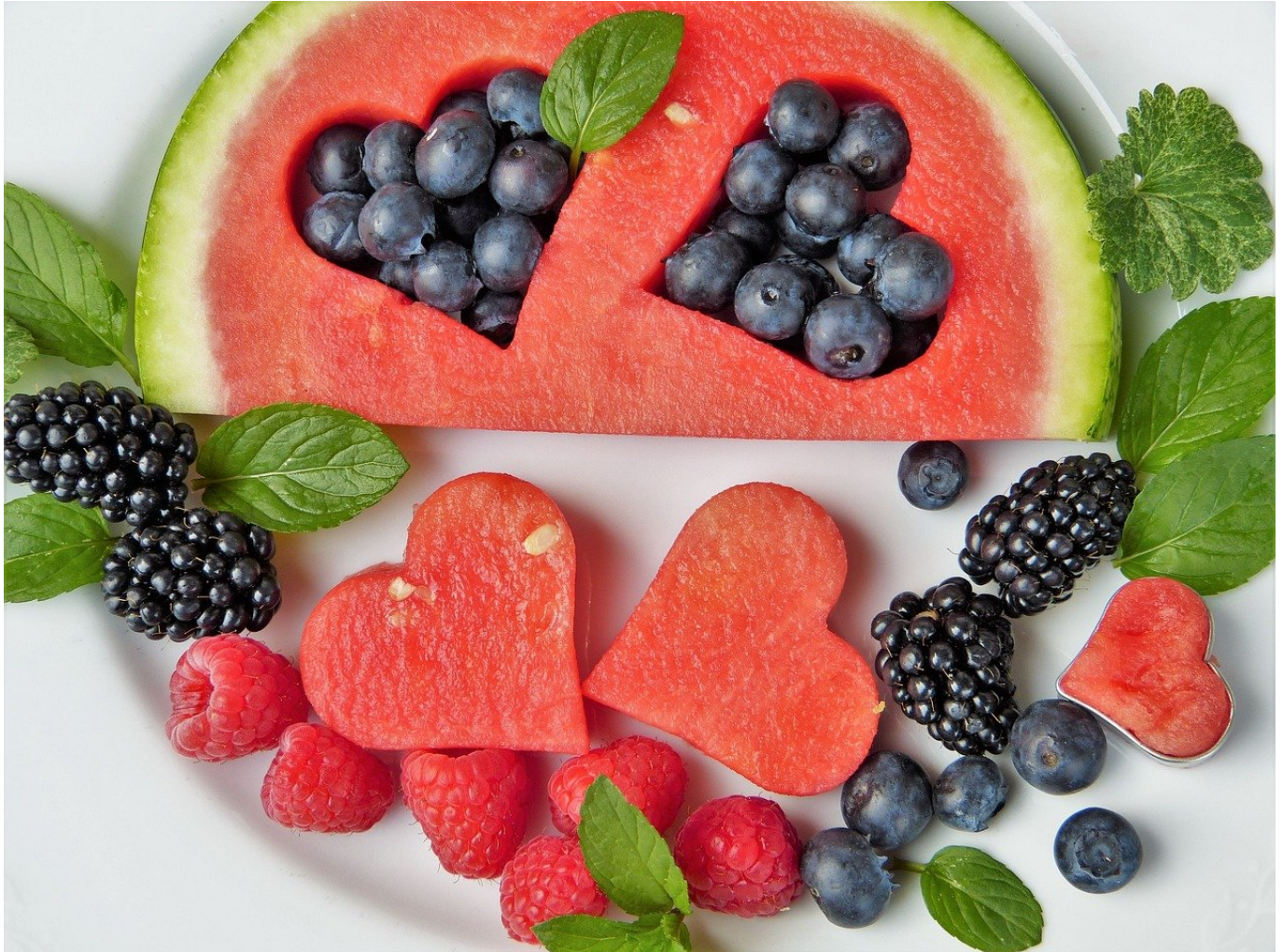

Definitions of "Dessert" as a noun

- *A dish served as the last course of a meal.*
- *The sweet course eaten at the end of a meal.*



Synonyms of "Dessert" as a noun (7 Words)

- afters** A dish served as the last course of a meal.
*They were both yellow carded for a spot of **afters** before half time.*
- last course** A unit of weight equal to 4,000 pounds.
- pudding** The dessert course of a meal.
*A good helping of **pudding**.*
- second course** 1/60 of a minute; the basic unit of time adopted under the Systeme International d'Unites.
- sweet** A sweet dish forming a course of a meal a pudding or dessert.
*The **sweets** of office.*
- sweet course** A dish served as the last course of a meal.
- sweet dish** The property of tasting as if it contains sugar.



Usage Examples of "Dessert" as a noun

- *A dessert of chocolate mousse.*



Associations of "Dessert" (30 Words)

- appetizer** Food or drink to stimulate the appetite (usually served before a meal or as the first course.
*The afternoon games served as an **appetizer** for the evening's heavyweight clash between Borussia Dortmund and Bayern Munich.*
- bread** The bread or wafer used in the Eucharist.
*His day job puts **bread** on the table.*
- breakfast** Eat breakfast.
*I often have toast for my **breakfast**.*
- cake** Baked goods made from or based on a mixture of flour, sugar, eggs, and fat.
*A **cake** of soap.*
- chocolate** A sweet made of or covered with chocolate.
*The former Great Western colours of **chocolate** and cream.*

cinnamon	Spice from the dried aromatic bark of the Ceylon cinnamon tree used as rolled strips or ground. A cinnamon cake.
confection	Make into a confection. His elaborate pop confections .
confectionery	A shop that sells sweets and chocolates. Items of confectionery .
cookie	A packet of data sent by a web server to a browser, which is returned by the browser each time it subsequently accesses the same server, used to identify the user or track their access to the server. She s a tough cookie .
delicious	Delightful. A delicious irony.
dine	Eat dinner. We dined at a restaurant.
dinner	A party of people assembled to have dinner together. Eric sits next to Beth at the dinner table.
eat	Eat a meal take a meal. She was eating a banana.
flavor	Lend flavor to.
flavour	A substance used to alter or enhance the taste of food or drink a flavouring. Adding sun dried tomatoes gives the sauce extra flavour .
food	Any substance that can be metabolized by an animal to give energy and build tissue. We need food and water.
lunch	Eat lunch. Do join us for lunch .
luncheon	A formal lunch, or a formal word for lunch. A ladies luncheon was taking place.
meal	The food eaten during a meal. The evening meal .
pancake	With reference to an aircraft make or cause to make a pancake landing. Crispy pancakes filled with cheese.
partake	Consume. Visitors can partake in golfing or clay pigeon shooting.

pie	A baked dish of fruit, or meat and vegetables, typically with a top and base of pastry. <i>A good meal of hot pie and peas.</i>
postprandial	Occurring or done after a meal. <i>An annual postprandial blood glucose test.</i>
pudding	The intestines of a pig or sheep stuffed with oatmeal, spices, and meat and boiled. <i>A good helping of pudding.</i>
refreshment	Activity that refreshes and recreates; activity that renews your health and spirits by enjoyment and relaxation. <i>Time for rest and refreshment by the pool.</i>
snack	Eat a snack eat lightly. <i>It s clear from the pics that her new husband is a total snack.</i>
sugar	A sweet crystalline substance obtained from various plants especially sugar cane and sugar beet consisting essentially of sucrose and used as a sweetener in food and drink. <i>A sugar bowl.</i>
sweet	The sweet part or element of something. <i>A sweet disposition.</i>
treacle	Cloying sentimentality or flattery. <i>Enough of this treacle let s get back to business.</i>
