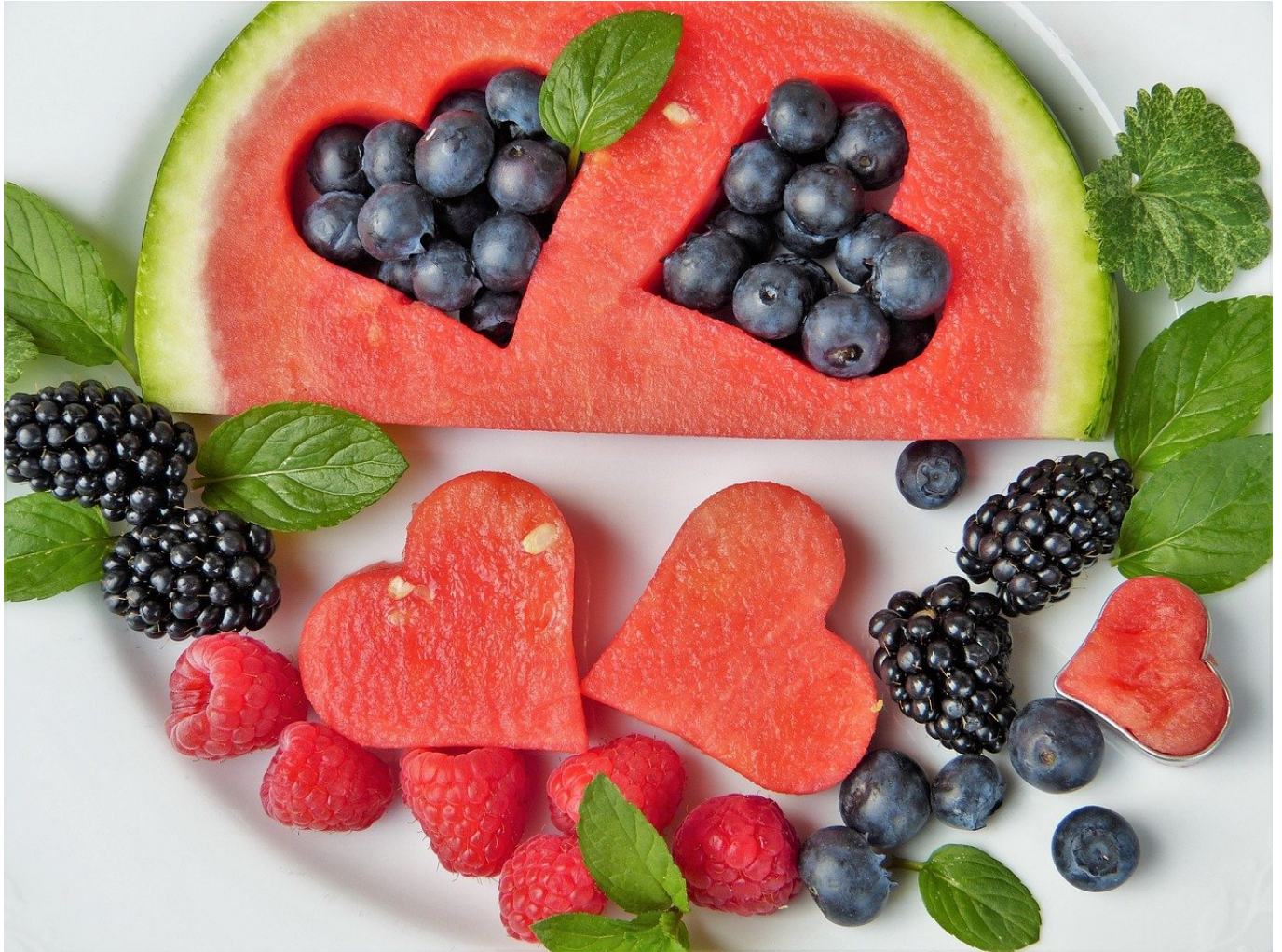

### **Definitions of "Dessert" as a noun**

- *A dish served as the last course of a meal.*
- *The sweet course eaten at the end of a meal.*



## Synonyms of "Dessert" as a noun (7 Words)

<b>afters</b>	A dish served as the last course of a meal. <i>They were both yellow carded for a spot of <b>afters</b> before half time.</i>
<b>last course</b>	A unit of weight equal to 4,000 pounds.
<b>pudding</b>	The dessert course of a meal. <i>A good helping of <b>pudding</b>.</i>
<b>second course</b>	1/60 of a minute; the basic unit of time adopted under the Systeme International d'Unites.
<b>sweet</b>	A sweet dish forming a course of a meal a pudding or dessert. <i>The <b>sweets</b> of office.</i>
<b>sweet course</b>	A dish served as the last course of a meal.
<b>sweet dish</b>	The property of tasting as if it contains sugar.

## Associations of "Dessert" (30 Words)

<b>appetizer</b>	Food or drink to stimulate the appetite (usually served before a meal or as the first course. <i>The afternoon games served as an <b>appetizer</b> for the evening's heavyweight clash between Borussia Dortmund and Bayern Munich.</i>
<b>bread</b>	The bread or wafer used in the Eucharist. <i>His day job puts <b>bread</b> on the table.</i>
<b>breakfast</b>	Eat breakfast. <i>I often have toast for my <b>breakfast</b>.</i>
<b>cake</b>	Baked goods made from or based on a mixture of flour, sugar, eggs, and fat. <i>A <b>cake</b> of soap.</i>
<b>chocolate</b>	A sweet made of or covered with chocolate. <i>The former Great Western colours of <b>chocolate</b> and cream.</i>



<b>cinnamon</b>	Spice from the dried aromatic bark of the Ceylon cinnamon tree used as rolled strips or ground. A <b>cinnamon</b> cake.
<b>confection</b>	Make into a confection. His elaborate pop <b>confections</b> .
<b>confectionery</b>	A shop that sells sweets and chocolates. Items of <b>confectionery</b> .
<b>cookie</b>	A packet of data sent by a web server to a browser, which is returned by the browser each time it subsequently accesses the same server, used to identify the user or track their access to the server. She s a tough <b>cookie</b> .
<b>delicious</b>	Delightful. A <b>delicious</b> irony.
<b>dine</b>	Eat dinner. We <b>dined</b> at a restaurant.
<b>dinner</b>	A party of people assembled to have dinner together. Eric sits next to Beth at the <b>dinner</b> table.
<b>eat</b>	Eat a meal take a meal. She was <b>eating</b> a banana.
<b>flavor</b>	Lend flavor to.
<b>flavour</b>	A substance used to alter or enhance the taste of food or drink a flavouring. Adding sun dried tomatoes gives the sauce extra <b>flavour</b> .
<b>food</b>	Any substance that can be metabolized by an animal to give energy and build tissue. We need <b>food</b> and water.
<b>lunch</b>	Eat lunch. Do join us for <b>lunch</b> .
<b>luncheon</b>	A formal lunch, or a formal word for lunch. A ladies <b>luncheon</b> was taking place.
<b>meal</b>	The food eaten during a meal. The evening <b>meal</b> .
<b>pancake</b>	With reference to an aircraft make or cause to make a pancake landing. Crispy <b>pancakes</b> filled with cheese.
<b>partake</b>	Consume. Visitors can <b>partake</b> in golfing or clay pigeon shooting.

<b>pie</b>	A baked dish of fruit, or meat and vegetables, typically with a top and base of pastry. <i>A good meal of hot <b>pie</b> and peas.</i>
<b>postprandial</b>	Occurring or done after a meal. <i>An annual <b>postprandial</b> blood glucose test.</i>
<b>pudding</b>	The intestines of a pig or sheep stuffed with oatmeal, spices, and meat and boiled. <i>A good helping of <b>pudding</b>.</i>
<b>refreshment</b>	Activity that refreshes and recreates; activity that renews your health and spirits by enjoyment and relaxation. <i>Time for rest and <b>refreshment</b> by the pool.</i>
<b>snack</b>	Eat a snack eat lightly. <i>It s clear from the pics that her new husband is a total <b>snack</b>.</i>
<b>sugar</b>	A sweet crystalline substance obtained from various plants especially sugar cane and sugar beet consisting essentially of sucrose and used as a sweetener in food and drink. <i>A <b>sugar</b> bowl.</i>
<b>sweet</b>	The sweet part or element of something. <i>A <b>sweet</b> disposition.</i>
<b>treacle</b>	Cloying sentimentality or flattery. <i>Enough of this <b>treacle</b> let s get back to business.</i>
