- A person or thing that destroys something.
- A small fast lightly armored but heavily armed warship.
- A small, fast warship, especially one equipped for a defensive role against submarines and aircraft.
- A person who destroys or ruins or lays waste to.





Synonyms of "Destroyer" as a noun (13 Words)

<u>assassin</u>	A member of the Nizari branch of Ismaili Muslims at the time of the Crusades, when the newly established sect ruled part of northern Persia (1094-1256). They were renowned as militant fanatics, and were popularly reputed to use hashish before going on murder missions. Assassinators of kings and emperors.
homicidal maniac	An insane person.
<u>killer</u>	An extremely difficult or unpleasant thing. <i>Heart disease is the biggest killer in the United States.</i>
liquidator	A person (usually appointed by a court of law) who liquidates assets or preserves them for the benefit of affected parties.
mass murderer	The common people generally.
<u>murderer</u>	A person who commits murder. Convicted murderer s.



ruiner	A person who or thing which ruins something or someone.
serial killer	A serialized set of programs.
slaughterer	A person who slaughters or dresses meat for market.
terminator	A person or thing that terminates something.
undoer	A person who destroys or ruins or lays waste to. Jealousy was his undoer .
uprooter	A person who destroys or ruins or lays waste to. <i>Uprooter</i> s <i>of gravestones.</i>
waster	A discarded piece of defective pottery. You are a great waster of time.



Usage Examples of "Destroyer" as a noun

- A destroyer of the environment.
- Poverty can be a destroyer of lives.
- This starfish has a bad reputation as a destroyer of coral reefs.
