Infinitive **to determinate**

Present Tense **determinate / determinates**

Past Tense **determinated**Present Participle **determinating**Past Participle **determinated**

Conjugate Determinate

Determinate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I determinate
You determinate
He/She/It determinates They determinate

Determinate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am determinating We are determinating
You are determinating You are determinating
He/She/It is determinating They are determinating

Determinate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have determinated We have determinated You have determinated He/She/It has determinated They have determinated

Determinate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been determinating
You have been determinating
You have been determinating
He/She/It has been determinating
They have been determinating

Determinate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I determinated We determinated You determinated You determinated He/She/It determinated They determinated

Determinate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was determinating We were determinating
You were determinating
He/She/It was determinating They were determinating

Determinate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had determinated We had determinated You had determinated He/She/It had determinated They had determinated

Determinate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been determinating
You had been determinating
He/She/It had been determinating
They had been determinating

Determinate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will determinate
You will determinate
He/She/It will determinate
They will determinate

Determinate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be determinating
You will be determinating
He/She/It will be determinating
They will be determinating

Determinate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have determinated We will have determinated You will have determinated He/She/It will have determinated They will have determinated

Determinate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been determinating
You will have been determinating
He/She/It will have been determinating
They will have been determinating
