Past Tense	<b>diagnosed</b>
Present Participle	<b>diagnosing</b>
Past Participle	<b>diagnosed</b>

**Plural**

I **diagnose**                      We **diagnose**  
You **diagnose**                  You **diagnose**  
He/She/It **diagnoses**      They **diagnose**

**Diagnose in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am diagnosing**              We **are diagnosing**  
You **are diagnosing**          You **are diagnosing**  
He/She/It **is diagnosing**      They **are diagnosing**

**Diagnose in Present Perfect Tense**

**Plural**

I **have diagnosed**              We **have diagnosed**  
You **have diagnosed**          You **have diagnosed**  
He/She/It **has diagnosed**      They **have diagnosed**

I **have been diagnosing**          We **have been diagnosing**  
You **have been diagnosing**      You **have been diagnosing**

**We will have diagnosed**

**You will have diagnosed**
