Diagnosicate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I **am diagnos**icating We **are diagnos**icating
You **are diagnos**icating You **are diagnos**icating
He/She/It **is diagnos**icating They **are diagnos**icating

Diagnosicate in Present Perfect Tense

I **have diagnos**icated We **have diagnos**icated

Diagnosicate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was diagnosticating	We were diagnosticating

I had been diagnosticating	We had been diagnosticating
You had been diagnosticating	You had been diagnosticating
He/She/It had been diagnosticating	They had been diagnosticating

Diagnosticate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I will diagnosticate	We will diagnosticate
You will diagnosticate	You will diagnosticate
He/She/It will diagnosticate	They will diagnosticate

Diagnosticate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be diagnosticating	We will be diagnosticating
You will be diagnosticating	You will be diagnosticating
He/She/It will be diagnosticating	They will be diagnosticating

Diagnosticate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have diagnosticated

We will have diagnosticated

You will have diagnosticated

You will have diagnosticated

He/She/It will have diagnosticated **They will have diagnosticated**

I will have been diagnosticating

We will have been diagnosticating

You will have been diagnosticating

You will have been diagnosticating

He/She/It will have been diagnosticating **They will have been diagnosticating**
