Definitions of "Diagram" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “diagram” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A drawing intended to explain how something works; a drawing showing the relation between the parts.*
- *A figure composed of lines that is used to illustrate a definition or statement or to aid in the proof of a proposition.*
- *A graphical schedule for operating railway locomotives and rolling stock in order to provide a desired service.*
- *A simplified drawing showing the appearance, structure, or workings of something; a schematic representation.*



Synonyms of "Diagram" as a noun (5 Words)

artist's impression All the copies of a work printed at one time.

drawing

The art or activity of making drawings.
*It is shown by the **drawing** in Fig 7.*

illustration

An illustrative example.
*By way of **illustration** I refer to the following case.*

line drawing

Space for one line of print (one column wide and 1/14 inch deep) used to measure advertising.

picture

A situation treated as an observable object.
*Poor **picture** quality.*

Diagram as a Verb

Definitions of "Diagram" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "diagram" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Represent (something) in graphic form.*
- *Make a schematic or technical drawing of that shows interactions among variables or how something is constructed.*
- *Schedule the operations of (a locomotive or train) according to a diagram.*



Synonyms of "Diagram" as a verb (1 Word)

plot Mark out or allocate (points) on a graph.
They **plotted** the overthrow of the government.



Usage Examples of "Diagram" as a verb

- *The experiment is diagrammed on page fourteen.*

architect

A person who is responsible for inventing or realizing a particular idea or project.

*We are seeking an experienced software **architect** to join our scientific computing team.*

artwork

Photographs or other visual representations in a printed publication.

*A collection of **artwork** from tribal cultures.*

blueprint

Make a blueprint of.

*The scheme was a **blueprint** for future development programmes.*

cartography

The science or practice of drawing maps.

chart

Of a record sell enough copies to enter the music charts at a particular position.

*She topped the **charts** for eight weeks.*

chiaroscuro	A monochrome picture made by using several different shades of the same color. <i>The chiaroscuro of cobbled streets.</i>
denouement	The final part of a play, film, or narrative in which the strands of the plot are drawn together and matters are explained or resolved. <i>I waited by the eighteenth green to see the denouement.</i>
draft	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. <i>The White Sox chose him in the 13th round of the 1990 draft.</i>
draftsmanship	The creation of artistic pictures or diagrams.
drawing	The act of moving a load by drawing or pulling. <i>The drawing of water from the well.</i>
exploded	(of a diagram) showing the components of a mechanism in the normal relative positions but slightly separated from each other. <i>Teams are analysing fragments from the two exploded bombs.</i>
flowchart	A diagram of the sequence of operations in a computer program or an accounting system.
formulaic	Produced in accordance with a mechanically followed rule or style. <i>Formulaic expressions such as <i>Once upon a time</i>.</i>
graph	Represent by means of a graph.
graphic	A graphical item displayed on a screen or stored as data. <i>A graphic account of the riots.</i>
intrigue	Form intrigues for in an underhand manner. <i>Within the region's borders is a wealth of interest and intrigue.</i>
machination	A plot or scheme.
maneuver	A plan for attaining a particular goal. <i>He made a great maneuver.</i>
map	Represent an area on a map make a map of. <i>You ought to know my map by now.</i>
mapping	(genetics) the process of locating genes on a chromosome.
plan	A drawing or diagram made by projection on a horizontal plane especially one showing the layout of a building or one floor of a building. <i>Plan an attack.</i>
plat	Make a plat of. <i>He bought back the site platted it and named it after his realtor.</i>
plot	Secretly make plans to carry out (an illegal or harmful action). <i>The characters were well drawn but the plot was banal.</i>
precis	Make a precis of a text or speech.

- project** Project on a screen.
A **project** to build a new power station.
- representation** A factual statement made by one party in order to induce another party to enter into a contract.
*The Law Society will make **representations** to the Lord Chancellor.*
- schematic** In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit.
*Freeman constructs a highly **schematic** reading of the play.*
- strategically** With regard to strategy.
Strategically important ports.
- summary** Briefly giving the gist of something.
A **summary** formulation of a wide ranging subject.
- synopsis** A brief summary or general survey of something.
